Scope & SEQUENCE FOR ELEMENTARY (AGES 6-10 YEARS)



GENERAL GROUP ACTVITIES (26 MINUTES)

CHECK- IN & WELCOME (10 MINS)

Ensure you are all ready and the class is set up ahead of the children's arrival. Be at the door to welcome the children. Greet each child by name. To create a warm, welcoming atmosphere, you can play Praise song by Loveworld singers in the background.

If you have a meeter/greeter team, that would be nice too; they can take the children around, showing them the lesson-related decorations to arouse their interest for what's ahead in the service. Use Loveworld Children's Ministry Attendance Charts for your check-in and registration of the kids as they come in. If you have a lesson-related sticker, this would be a good time to hand them out for that extra special welcome and to give the children a peek into what is to come in the Bible lesson for the day.

ASSEMBLY (3 MINS)

Assembly time gives opportunity for interaction across all age groupings as one big group. Children should be ushered to the assembly area straight after completing the check-in process. The Assembly Leader should be of a boisterous, cheerful personality that can engage every child and set the tone to help them get excited and ready for the day's activities before they break away to their individual classes.

OPENING PRAYER (3MINS)

Lead the children in prayer. Engage them to speak in tongues and to give thanks to God. Round up the payer session.

PRAISE & WORSHIP TIME (10MINS)

Lead the children in praise worship and encourage them to participate actively. Choose songs that extol our great God of glory, our loving Jesus and the awesome person of the Holy Spirit. Let the children dance and sing along.

SMALL GROUP ACTVITIES (34 MINUTES)

Rhapsody of Realities Time (5 mins)

Get the children to be seated comfortably and read the devotional story in the recent <u>Rhapsody of Realties Devotional for Early Readers</u>. Make the reading as interactive as possible. Lead the children in the confessions enclosed with the message in the devotional story.

Special Healing Ministration Video Segment (5mins)

Get the children to watch the Healing School Video of the Week. This would be a good opportunity to talk about the importance of the miraculous in our Christian Walk today.... Even as kids! www.healingstreams.tv

Interest Builder Activity (3 mins)

As a warm-up to the lesson, lead the children in the interest builder activity as highlighted in the lesson overview enclosed with this curriculum.

Bible Lesson Time (15 mins)

Teacher: This is a very important segment in the day's activities.

Refer to the lesson summary in this curriculum and read it thoroughly, including the further scriptures, to ensure that you get all the shades of the lesson to help your presentation to the children.

Remember, you need to present the lesson in an engaging, interesting and interactive way that consistently captures the attention of your Preteens kids. Use the lesson illustrated Teaching picture and other tools enclosed with this curriculum.

New Kids Welcome (3 mins)

Don't forget to welcome new children (first timers) specially, with our Christ Embassy welcome song and encourage the regular kids to go over and say hello to make them feel even more welcome.

Announcement (3 mins)

This is the time to make announcement to the kids about Global ministry programs and events and also children's ministry initiatives for them to participate.



RELATE TIME (20 MINUTES)

Lesson Review & Talk Back Time (2 mins)

Encourage feedback from the children. Use the lesson discussion guide provided with this curriculum. Ask the kids questions in line with the Bible lesson you have just taught and give opportunity for them to ask you questions if they have any as well.

This would be a good time to use your reward stickers for pupils who answered right and made any attempt to answer a question.

Confession (2 mins)

Say out loud the confession for the day and have the children repeat the words of confession after you several times. Let them know that when we speak God's word like this in bold confessions, speaking the same things God has said in His word in agreement with him, we walk in the reality of what the scriptures declare as the Bible says "you shall have what you say" (Mark 11:23).

Scripture Memorization (4 mins)

One of the ways children learn is by repetition. Refer to the scripture memorization tip provided to help the children learn and memorize the scripture verse for the day.

- o Lesson Memory Verse
- o Message-For-The-Year Memory Verse
- o Message- For-The-Month Memory Verse

Prayer (2 mins)

Lead the children in a simple prayer and give thanks for the message they have just received, thanking the Lord for the unlimited access that we have to Him.

Salvation Moment (3 mins)

This is an opportunity for any child who is yet to be born again to receive salvation. Give a brief message on the gospel and Christ's work of salvation. Ask the children to indicate by show of hands their desire to be born again and lead them in the prayer of salvation. Let them know the reality of what has just transpired – they are now a child of God and Jesus has come to live in them by His Spirit. Glory!

Teacher: Pray this prayer with any child who indicates he/she wants to receive Christ to live in him/her.

Dear God, I come to you in the Name of Jesus Christ. I confess with my mouth, Jesus Christ is Lord and believe with my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I receive Jesus today to be my Lord and friend. I am born again. I am a child of God Now and I've got the life of God in me. Amen.

Tithe & Offering Time (2 Mins)

Giving Is Our Culture!

Lead the children in a simple prayer of thanksgiving and guide them to give their offerings and special seeds. Bless the offerings afterwards.

Snack & Mingle Time (2 mins)

Give the children a snack and packaged drink/water to get them refreshed for the next set of activities in the service. Encourage them to mingle and interact with each other.

ACTIVITY TIME (3 MINS)

Early Elementary Kids (Ages 6-7years)

Refer to the lesson-related activity in the 'Activity Section' in the curriculum for ages 6-7years and ensure you have sufficient supplies for the activities for the number of kids in your class. Have fun with your kids and remember to point out highlights from the lessons as the kids do the activities.

Upper Elementary Kids (Ages 8-10years)

Refer to the lesson-related activity in the 'Activity Section' in the curriculum for ages 8-10years and ensure you have sufficient supplies for the activities for the number of kids in your class. Have fun with your kids and remember to point out highlights from the lessons as the kids do the activities.

CELL MEETING TIME (30 MINUTES)

The children should be supervised to split into their various cell groups for their cell meetings. Help first timers join a cell.

Adult Cell Supervisor/Teacher:

Remember to use the <u>Cell Meeting Outline</u> and make available to the cell leader the weekly cell meeting template relevant to the cell meeting type for the week.

NOTE: Adult Cell Supervisor or Teacher should participate in the cell meetings.

CHECKOUT TIME (10 MINUTES)

Going Home Snack Time (3 Mins)

Please give the children a take-home snack to send them along the way home. For children who are much younger, give snack packs to the parents or guardian at pick-up time.

Parent Page & Take Home Activity (2 Mins)

Give each child a copy of the Elementary Resource and Take-Home activity sheets as applicable for the day.

Talking Session & Closing Prayer (5 Mins)

Lead the children in the closing prayers, a brief word affirmation session and benediction. Remember to tell them you look forward to seeing them next week.

Introduction

Lesson 2 is titled, **"FAITH IS OUR LIFESTYLE".** The children will learn that it is by faith in God and His word that they came to receive Jesus as their Lord and saviour and without faith; there is no assurance of salvation. In God's kingdom, faith is our lifestyle, it isn't something we try to acquire; it's inherent in us. Glory to God.

Lesson 3 is titled, "NEVER GET FRANTIC". The children will learn that getting frantic or flustered in the face of dire challenges can give room for fear. Always, the Lord tells us not to fear. We're creatures of faith and not fear. In Mark 4, Jesus was in the boat with His disciples and there was a tempest; he spoke calmness to the storm. The children will learn to speak with boldness in faith, but not out of fear in the face of challenging situations.

Lesson 4 is titled, "AFFIRM THE WORD IN FAITH". The children will learn that affirming the Word of God is a principle of the Kingdom that includes salvation and everything else (Romans 10:9-10). 




ATTENTION TEACHER:

Tell the Bible Story Hebrews 11:3-11 NIV

(Decide the method you will use. Examples may include showing teaching pictures, drawing, using puppets, costumes, drama or others. Make it interesting)

By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible. By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead.

By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death: "He could not be found, because God had taken him away." For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God. And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family. By his faith he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness that is in keeping with faith.

By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is God. And by faith even Sarah, who was past childbearing age, was enabled to bear children because she considered him faithful who had made the promise.

Let's Talk

Today, we will discuss the topic, "What is faith?" Can anyone tell us what faith is? (Kindly allow the children to respond and acknowledge each child's participation). Faith is an unshakable belief in God and the promises of God. Faith is the title deed. If your father bought a piece of land, he would not carry the land with him everywhere telling everybody, 'see the land I bought'. He would have document to that land called a 'title deed'. If someone requested a proof of ownership, all he needs to do is simply show him or her his title deed as proof of ownership. Your title deed is the evidence of unseen realities, which is the land your father bought.

Faith is the response of the human spirit to the Word of God. We are expected to put complete confidence in everything God tells us and do all He tells us to do. When we act on God's Word, we are in essence saying to God, "I really believe You'll do exactly what You say you will do. Praise God!

Teacher; kindly assign a child to read Hebrews 11:1

In the scripture we just read, faith is the confident assurance that something we want is going to happen. If we have hope for anything, faith is what gives us assurance by making us sure of what we hope for. Faith gives you every reason to affirm something is yours before you see it with your physical eyes. Why? Faith is the confident assurance of things hoped for; it calls real those things that are not physically observable. It calls them as though they were. Hallelujah!

Jesus said that with our faith, we can do great things in our lives and in the lives of those around us (Mark 11:23). The second part of Hebrew 11:1 CEV says, "Faith gives us proof of what we cannot see". It is faith that makes us believe that we have what we cannot see with the physical eyes. Another translation says, it is the evidence of things not seen, that is, the evidence of unseen realities.

In other words, you are sure of something that you have not seen with your physical eyes but you believe and accept it as real just because the Word of God says it is real. The Bible says, faith calls those things that be not as though they were (Romans 4:17). You did not see the miracle but you are declaring about it. You just finished an examination, the teacher hasn't even started marking and you go about declaring; "I am excellent and top in my class". Hallelujah!!!

That's faith! When you do this, your life will be from glory to glory as nothing shall be impossible with you. **Hallelujah!**

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God. Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

Let's Talk

But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him (Hebrews 11:6). Faith is the way God wants us to live, "Without faith it is impossible to please [God]." Not difficult, but impossible. There's no other lifestyle pleasing to God outside of a lifestyle of faith.

Every Christian has faith. The Bible says, "For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith" (Romans 12:3). "Every man that is among you" means every one of us in God's house; God has made available to us, "the measure" of faith, not "a measure" of faith. This means each of us received the same measure of faith when we received salvation. When you heard the Gospel, it came packaged with faith, and when you acted on it, faith was imparted to your spirit, to use for the rest of your Christian journey. By using it, you strengthen it, and by hearing more of God's Word, you increase it.

Faith is not some panic button you push during a time of crisis, it's a lifestyle. The Bible says, the just shall live by faith. The just will live step by step, and day by day, by the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Sometimes, when people face challenges, they'd say, "I've been using my faith, but nothing is happening." That's because they're struggling to make their faith work. Speak faith-filled words ever before you face challenges, so that when it does show up, your faith will be steadfast and understanding.

Learn from Jesus: He talked to trees, waves, water, fishes etc., letting us know that everything in life has intelligence and that sound conveys energy. Therefore, apart from talking to your body to be in health, learn to talk to things of everything in your care and under your watch, speak to it, they all have intelligence. Use your mouth to retain their value and keep them in perfect condition.

The Lord Jesus, through His teachings and parables, unveiled faith as a lifestyle; it's not something to exercise once or twice, but all the time. The best way, therefore, to cultivate the faith lifestyle is by having a perfect understanding of His message. For instance, in Mark 9:23, He said, "...If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." He didn't say that because of a particular day's challenge. He wanted you to have the mentality that anything is possible; you can do anything, and achieve anything when you believe. Glory to God!

Tell the Bible Story

Mark 4:35-41 NIV

(Decide the method you will use. Examples may include showing teaching pictures, drawing, using puppets, costumes, drama or others. Make it interesting)

That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?"

He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" They were terrified and asked each other "Who is this" even the wind and the waves obey Him.

Let's Talk

And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm (Mark 4:39).

Jesus was in the boat with His disciples and despite the storm, His reaction shows us how to respond when we're confronted with challenges. Always, the Lord tells us not to fear. Never get frantic or flustered. We're creatures of faith and not fear.

In Mark 4:37, "And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full". Rattled by fear, the disciples cried out to the Master who was peacefully asleep at the rear of the boat. He wasn't one to be flustered by circumstances.



When He woke up, He didn't say, "This storm is quite tumultuous and a serious threat to our lives, I need to talk to the Father." No! His amazing and inspiring response to the storm was, "Peace, be still!" Hallelujah! Some Christians find themselves in similar situations and respond in fear. They start speaking in tongues out of panic; no! Speak in tongues, but never out of fear. Speak in tongues with boldness, without fear and with the assurance that you already have the victory.

Praying out of frenzy negates your faith; it's ineffective. It's not wrong to immediately start speaking in tongues when you're in certain situations, but you must know why you're speaking in tongues at such times. It should be to stir your spirit to pick the right words to deal with the situation.

While speaking in tongues, the Holy Spirit will also give you utterance in spiritual incantations which are coded words of solutions and victory for the circumstances. Hallelujah! Refuse to fear; remember who you are, and speak as the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. Hallelujah!

Let's Talk

For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind (2 Timothy 1:7). It's clear what God hasn't given to us, and what He has given us: He's not given us the spirit of fear, cowardice or timidity. Rather, He's given us the spirit of power, love, and a sound mind. Every so often, declare this as the reality of your life.

Never express difficulties in comprehending or retaining anything. Never confess dullness of the mind; rather, affirm that you possess an extraordinary amplitude of comprehension and exceptional intellect, marked by wit and intelligence. You have an expansive understandin and brilliance of mind through the Holy Spirit. Say this often to yourself.



Also, don't build vocabulary around forgetfulness. Don't say, "O, I just forgot; what a forgetful me" No! You have a sound mind; a mind that retains and recalls information effectively. You have a sharp memory and a firm capacity to remember important details, experiences and knowledge. You're excellent and a success! Your mental acuity and your cognitive abilities are top- notch. Guess what? that's what the Word says about you. Glory to God!

Some think it's fashionable to talk fear, but the Christian isn't built to fear. We're creatures of faith. Do not express fear, eschew the language of fear and talk faith always. Talk boldly! You're born of God, therefore, fear has no place in your life. Proclaim the Word of faith with conviction and confidence.





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
