Scope & SEQUENCE

FOR ELEMENTARY (AGES 6-10 YEARS)

GENERAL GROUP ACTVITIES (26 MINUTES)



1. CHECK- IN & WELCOME (5mins)

Ensure you are all ready and the class is set up ahead of the children's arrival. Be at the door to welcome the children. Greet each child by name. To create a warm, welcoming atmosphere, you can play Praise song by Loveworld singers in the background.

If you have a meeter/greeter team, that would be nice too; they can take the children around, showing them the lesson-related decorations to arouse their interest for what's ahead in the service. Use Loveworld Children's Ministry Attendance Charts for your checkin and registration of the kids as they come in. If you have a lesson-related sticker, this would be a good time to hand them out for that extra special welcome and to give the children a peek into what is to come in the Bible lesson for the day.

2. ASSEMBLY

Assembly time gives opportunity for interaction across all age groupings as one big group. Children should be ushered to the assembly area straight after completing the check-in process. The Assembly Leader should be of a boisterous, cheerful personality that can engage every child and set the tone to help them get excited and ready for the day's activities before they break away to their individual classes.

SMALL GROUP ACTVITIES (1:15 MINUTES)

1. EXPLORE THE BIBLE TIME (20 minutes)

Rhapsody of Realities Time (3 minutes)

Get the children to be seated comfortably and read the devotional story in the recent <u>Rhapsody of Realties Devotional for Early Readers</u>. Make the reading as interactive as possible. Lead the children in the confessions enclosed with the message in the devotional story.

Interest Builder Activity (2 minutes)

As a warm-up to the lesson, lead the children in the interest builder activity as highlighted in the lesson overview enclosed with this curriculum.



Bible Lesson Time (15 minutes)

Teacher: This is a very important segment in the day's activities.

Refer to the lesson summary in this curriculum and read it thoroughly, including the further scriptures, to ensure that you get all the shades of the lesson to help your presentation to the children.



Remember, you need to present the lesson in an engaging, interesting and interactive way that consistently captures the attention of your Preteens kids. Use the lesson illustrated Teaching picture and other tools enclosed with this curriculum.

RELATE TIME (20 MINUTES)

Lesson Review & Talk Back Time (3 minutes)

Encourage feedback from the children. Use the **lesson discussion guide** provided with this curriculum. Ask the kids questions in line with the Bible lesson you have just taught and give opportunity for them to ask you questions if they have any as well.

This would be a good time to use your reward stickers for pupils who answered right and made any attempt to answer a question.



| Confession (2 minutes)

Say out loud the confession for the day and have the children repeat the words of confession after you several times. Let them know that when we speak God's word like this in bold confessions, speaking the same things God has said in His word in agreement with him, we walk in the reality of what the scriptures declare as the Bible says "you shall have what you say" (Mark 11:23).

Scripture Memorization (4 minutes)

One of the ways children learn is by repetition. Refer to the scripture memorization tip provided to help the children learn and memorize the scripture verse for the day.

- o Lesson Memory Verse
- o Message-For-The-Year Memory Verse
- o Message-For-The-Month Memory Verse

Prayer (2 minutes)

Lead the children in a simple prayer and give thanks for the message they have just received, thanking the Lord for the unlimited access that we have to Him.

Salvation Moment (3 minutes)

This is an opportunity for any child who is yet to be born again to receive salvation. Give a brief message on the gospel and Christ's work of salvation. Ask the children to indicate by show of hands their desire to be born again and lead them in the prayer of salvation. Let them know the reality of what has just transpired - they are now a child of God and Jesus has come to live in them by His Spirit. Glory!

Teacher: Pray this prayer with any child who indicates he/she wants to receive Christ to live in him/her.

Dear God, I come to you in the Name of Jesus Christ. I confess with my mouth, Jesus Christ is Lord and believe with my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I receive Jesus today to be my Lord and friend. I am born again. I am a child of God Now and I've got the life of God in me. Amen.

Tithe & Offering Time (2 Minutes)

Giving Is Our Culture!

Lead the children in a simple prayer of thanksgiving and guide them to give their offerings and special seeds. Bless the offerings afterwards.

Snack & Mingle Time (2 Minutes)

Give the children a snack and packaged drink/water to get them refreshed for the next set of activities in the service. Encourage them to mingle and interact with each other.

ACTIVITY TIME (2 MINUTES)

Early Elementary Kids (Ages 6-7years)

Refer to the lesson-related activity in the 'Activity Section' in the curriculum for ages 6-7years and ensure you have sufficient supplies for the activities for the number of kids in your class. Have fun with your kids and remember to point out highlights from the lessons as the kids do the activities.

Upper Elementary Kids (Ages 8-10years)

Refer to the lesson-related activity in the 'Activity Section' in the curriculum for ages 8-10 years and ensure you have sufficient supplies for the activities for the number of kids in your class. Have fun with your kids and remember to point out highlights from the lessons as the kids do the activities.

CELL MEETING TIME (25 MINUTES)

The children should be supervised to split into their various cell groups for their cell meetings. Help first timers join a cell.



Adult Cell Supervisor/Teacher:

Remember to use the <u>Cell Meeting Outline</u> and make available to the cell leader the weekly cell meeting template relevant to the cell meeting type for the week.

NOTE: Adult Cell Supervisor or Teacher should participate in the cell meetings.

CHECKOUT TIME (5 MINUTES)

Going Home Snack Time (2 minutes)

Please give the children a take-home snack to send them along the way home. For children who are much younger, give snack packs to the parents or guardian at pick-up time.

o Bible Reading Plan Slip & Take Home Activity (3 minutes)
Give each child a copy of the Elementary 2 Year Bible Reading Plan and Take-Home activity sheets as applicable for the day.

CLOSING (5 MINUTES)

Talking Session & Closing Prayer

 $Lead\ the\ children\ in\ the\ closing\ prayers, a\ brief\ word\ affirmation\ session\ and\ benediction.$

Remember to tell them you look forward to seeing them next week.





Tell the Bible Story

Acts 16:25-26

Kindly allow each of the kids read a verse of Acts 16:25-26 from the Bible



"...At midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed."



The Bible says, "Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand" (Psalm 149:6). Imagine Paul and Silas locked up in prison. It was a precarious situation. Nevertheless, at midnight, at the darkest hour of neglect; at that time when the pain and reality of their incarceration should be too much to bear, rather than become angry at God for "forsaking" them, they adopted the praises unto God, until there was a supernatural jailbreak! An earthquake erupted that shook the prison to its foundations, flinging the prison doors wide open and both men came out.

Where are you in your life today? What situation are you facing that seems insurmountable? Don't give up. Don't call a pity-party. Don't feel alone and forsaken; adopt the praise strategy. Praise God profusely from your spirit, not in anticipation of victory, but in victory. Praise Him, knowing that He always causes us to triumph in Christ, and makes manifest the savour of His knowledge by us in every place (2 Corinthians 2:14). Blessed be God!

Psalm 63:3-4 TLB "...Your love and kindness are better to me than life itself. How I praise you! I will bless you as long as I live, lifting up my hands to you in prayer."

The Bible says God has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ Jesus (Ephesians 1:3). This is enough to make you ecstatic with gratitude to the Lord every day of your life. How could anyone read or hear this and still be complaining? God wants us to give thanks every day, not complaints. It is a necessity, the Scripture is clear in saying that this is the will of God concerning you: "In everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus" (1 Thessalonians 5:18 NASB).

Complainers can't be fruitful in every good work; they can't be effective soul winners. Instead, complainers gripe about their perceived misfortune. Don't be that way; rather, give thanks. David said, "...I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1). Keep His praise in your mouth, not sometimes, but always. Get used to praising God. That's how victors live: they don't complain; they praise and give thanks to the Lord always. Praise the Lord!



Acts 13:2 - As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work where unto I have called them.



Fasting is a spiritual exercise, and it's one of the vital conditions necessary for effective praying. Fasting isn't the same as a hunger strike, neither is it about avoiding meals. After all, there are folks who sometimes wouldn't eat over a long period of time, probably because they're busy; that doesn't mean they're fasting. Fasting means turning your attention away from food, and turning it to God. As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work where unto I have called them (Acts 13:2).

Sometimes as Christians, we miss God's order of things. God is a God of order, and order gives meaning to things. For example, all around the world, people tend to confuse the order and say, "fasting and praying," instead of "praying and fasting." Praying comes before fasting in the Scriptures. Not understanding the right order may account for the reason many people fast without praying, which is largely a waste of time and effort. The emphasis should be on praying. It's a call to prayer, and because you're praying, you're consciously staying away from eating. The fast is on, because you're praying, not because you're not eating.

Acts 13:2 says, "As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, the Holy Ghost said...." Notice the order: they ministered to the Lord and fasted. How do you minister to the Lord? It's in worship, prayer, praise and thanksgiving. The focus was on ministering to the Lord, and because of this, they fasted. Then the Lord spoke to them after they had prayed.

When you take out time to pray, fast and minister to the Lord, you discipline your flesh in submission to the Word. This makes your spirit more receptive to God's Spirit, breaking down every resistance from your human senses, thus aiding your spirit to pray more correctly. Fasting also positions you rightly for God's Word to come to you. God may have been speaking to you, but you may not have picked His signals. But when you pray and fast, your spirit is conditioned to receive the guidance and direction He's giving you about your life, finances, family, academics, the future and something that's dear to you or that you're interested in.

This is God's will and purpose: He desires to talk to you personally and to have you understand Him clearly. He wants to do that for you more than you want it. The truth is, He's been doing it. But when your spirit is clouded with other matters, you can't hear Him clearly. That's the reason for fasting. We don't fast so God can hear our prayers, or so we can convince Him to do something for us. Fasting helps to position you where His Word can come to you, lift you, energize you, and position you to be in sync with His perfect will. Praise God!
