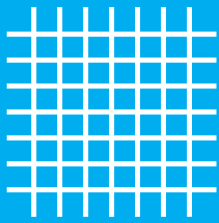

THE YEAR OF **REDEMPTION** SPECIALTY CURRICULUM PRELUDE

REV. CHRIS OYAKHILOME DSC. DSC. DD.

After I share this message with you, you're going to pray and in fact you will find even more reasons to pray. Do you like to hear the message of the year? God has something to tell us, He has something to say. I'm going to begin with an important word in the scripture. It's the word **REDEMPTION**.

In several English Dictionaries it's defined in the following ways;

1. It's the Act, process or instance of redeeming.
2. To buy or pay off, clear by payment
3. To redeem a mortgage, to buy back after a tax sale or mortgage for-closure.
4. To discharge or fulfil a pledge to someone.

They are few interesting ones that are relevant to our discussion for this year. They are very simple.

1. To deliver from sin and its consequences by sacrifice: Jesus paid the redeeming sacrifice for everyone and that's what the gospel of Jesus Christ is about. Salvation for man's soul/spirit. In this salvation, He gives us something. A lot of times, we talk of what He took away (my sin, my condemnation). Most people don't mention what He gave.

The death of Jesus was only a means to an end. The death of Jesus was not the ultimate. It wasn't God's ultimate plan. His death paid. Satisfying the claims of Justice for all men. His death settled the debt. But there was much more...

Christianity does not begin with the death of Jesus. It begins with the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Until a man believes in the resurrection of Jesus Christ, he cannot be saved. (Of course the lesser is Included in the greater). Through his death, He brought us Justification. This means to be acquitted or declared **NOT GUILTY**. When Jesus died, he died in our place. He was crucified in the place of sinners. He paid the penalty for Sin. Because He paid, you don't have to pay again. There is no such thing as Penance. No man could ever pay for his sin.

Justified doesn't suggest that He paid for you. Imagine that you were owing a debt and they are trying to pay the debt but you couldn't pay. A man comes to pay your debt for you... You paid, even though you didn't pay by yourself! Think about it...you actually paid for your sins in Jesus Christ. But Justification means to be declared Not guilty. It's something completely different from what Jesus did. The payment does not make you Justified.

In Justification you are said to be without guilt. You were discharged and acquitted. Why? Because the resurrection gave you a new life. It made you a new creature. One that never existed before. That's why you are Justified. You are Not the same man who committed the sin that was remitted. His resurrection gave you a new nature. That's what it means to be born again.

Romans 5- Read the whole chapter

2. The second one is to turn in vouchers or coupons for actual value. Did you know the scriptures that talk of Jesus vicarious death and resurrection are vouchers for redemption? Did you know that those verse are vouchers/coupons? You can take those coupons and present them for actual value.

3. To release from Debt or Bondage: This I find to be very interesting. Today's few masters must release their serf's. There are nations and organizations that are holding others in bondage today and holding them with debts that are unjustified. They must let them go. If they don't let them go in 2024, it will turn to an unrest; those who have found themselves in these illegitimate debts and bondage must extricate themselves from these detrimental associations and treaties.(I am speaking to individuals and to nations... Because this year is the year of Redemption).

You must extricate yourselves. You must become Bold. I speak to African and Asian nations. You must now Extricate yourselves and come out of this Bondage. It takes boldness, leadership and decisiveness. There are many of you at various levels. Don't wait for government, because sometimes, the government may not speak for you.

An idea: Sue the Government for making those payments. And sue with proof that the debts are illegal. You will win for your country, your organization and for yourself and your future. Wake up! There are answers. A group of you can sue that government. You can make them stop making the payments.

Sue the illegitimate claimants. Sue them at the National court. Youth Organizations, become bold. There is more than enough proof that the debts that are being claimed from Africa, Asia, Central America don't have to be paid. They have been overpaid. And it's time for **Redemption**.

Redemption is to extricate yourself from something detrimental. God is saying to those holding them: let my people go. This is a year that will bring changes. You cannot fear your adversary. It will empower them. Your adversary is not God. Your adversaries are not as strong as you think. In fact, they are weak.

What a year!

Make claims on what Christ gave you.

It's time! A sudden change is coming.

What is Redemption?

LESSON FOCUS

In today's class, we'll learn the meaning of redemption and how Jesus paid the price for our redemption. Glory to God!

BIBLE STORY:

Teacher/parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

2 Corinthians 5:14-21 NKJV

"For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."

BIBLE LESSON:

Wow, welcome to the year of "Redemption". First, let's learn the meaning of redemption.

In several English Dictionaries redemption is defined in the following ways;

1. It's the Act, process or instance of redeeming.
2. To buy or pay off, clear by payment
3. To redeem a mortgage, to buy back after a tax sale or mortgage foreclosure.
4. To discharge or fulfil a pledge to someone.

Our Man of God defines redemption as the process or means to deliver someone from sin and its consequences by sacrifice. This is how Jesus paid the redeeming sacrifice for everyone and that's what the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ is about. It is about salvation for man's soul/spirit.

The Lord Jesus redeemed man from sin at the cross, and His blood became the currency with which He paid for the sins of the whole world. Then He was buried, and on the third day, God raised Him from the dead with a new life. Now, He gives eternal life to those who believe in Him.

Through redemption we received salvation. A lot of times, we talk of what he took away (my sin, my condemnation). Most people don't mention what he gave (eternal life). The death of Jesus was only a means

to an end. The death of Jesus was not the ultimate. It wasn't God's ultimate plan. His death was the payment, that satisfy the claims of Justice for all men. His death settled the debt. but there was much more...

Through his death, he brought us Justification. This means to be acquitted or declared NOT GUILTY. Hallelujah! When Jesus died, he died in our place. He was crucified in the place of sinners. He paid the penalty for Sin. Because He paid, you don't have to pay again. No man could ever pay for his sin.

Justified doesn't suggest that He paid for you. Imagine that you were owing a debt and they are trying to pay the debt but you couldn't pay. A man comes to pay your debt for you... You paid, even though you didn't pay by yourself! Think about it...you actually paid for your sins in Jesus Christ. But Justification means to be declared not guilty. You're justified, redeemed and you're not the same man who committed the sin that Jesus paid for. (kindly read 2 Corinthians 5:17) You're born again and a new creature in Christ Jesus. Our man of God told us that you can celebrate the date you got born again, because its your birthday. Glory to God

Action

Ask the children to share their salvation experience and confirm if they remember the date they got born again.

Affirmations:

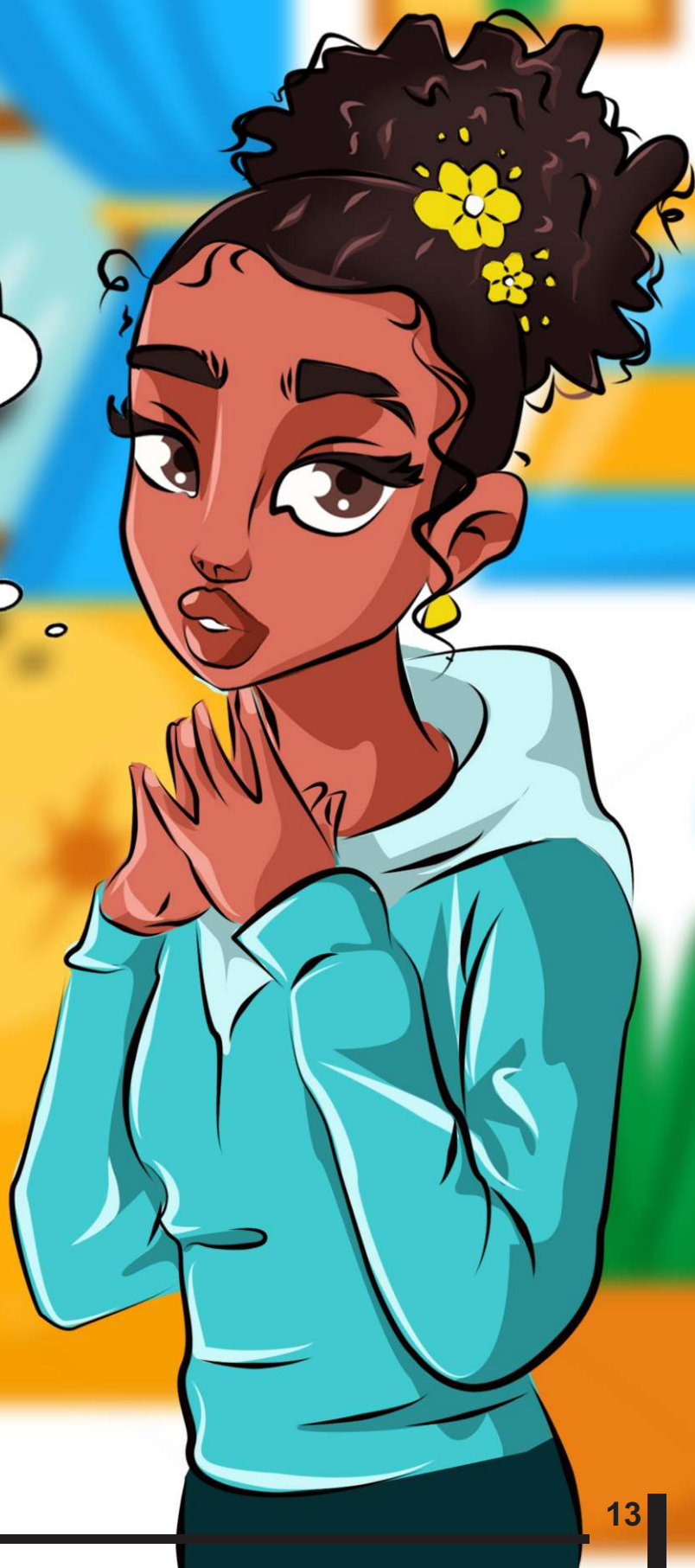
- ✓ **I am the righteousness of God, because I was born in Christ. Hallelujah!**

Scriptural Verses are Vouchers/ Coupons For You

LESSON FOCUS

In today's class, we'll learn about Scriptural verses on redemption that are vouchers and coupons.

BIBLE STORY:

Teacher/parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

Romans 3:21-24

"But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. There is no difference between Jew and Gentile, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus."

BIBLE LESSON:

A voucher is a small printed piece of paper that entitles the holder to a discount, or that may be exchanged for goods or services. A coupon is a voucher entitling the holder to a discount off a particular product. Either voucher or coupon, what is important is the guarantee for acquiring a products or enjoying a service for free.

In Romans 5:6-8 NIV, "You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly. Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous person, though for a good person someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us". Can you see that? There's no height or extent of sin that Christ has not redeemed. Jesus paid the redeeming sacrifice for everyone and that's what the gospel of Jesus Christ is about. Redemption refers to saving someone by paying a price. When Jesus died, He paid the price for man's redemption with His own life. The scriptures is written for us as proof of our redemption in Christ. These scriptures are the coupons and vouchers for us.

In Romans 8:1 the Bible says, "therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus". Our man of God told us that the scripture is our voucher to claim all that's ours in Christ. You can know your rights in Christ and still not claim it. Some of God's children are still leaving in guilt despite being born again. The word of God already declared you NOT GUILTY according to Romans 8:1 that we read. So why will you still allow guilt in your heart. Just as Christ was raised from the dead into a newness of life, the Christian has no past. You're a new creation, whatever wrong you did died with your old nature which in the presence of God doesn't exist anymore. That's why the Bible says in 2 Corinthians 5:17; "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature...", meaning that he is a new species, one that never existed before.

That's why it's wrong for a Christian to keep a consciousness of sin. Some are forever praying and asking God for forgiveness, because they're always overwhelmed by the burden of sin-consciousness. God wants you to walk free of guilt or condemnation. He wants you to walk in the light of your redemption, your righteousness, your justification, in Christ Jesus with the scriptures available as coupons/ vouchers for you.

Action

Read the Bible more this year. Study and meditate on God's word. The more you know the scriptures, the more coupons/vouchers you get.

MEMORY VERSE: Romans 5:8

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us".

Affirmations:

- ✓ I have all things that pertain to life and godliness, because Jesus paid the price for me to have and enjoy life to the full!
- ✓ I'm a new creation and I walk in the newness of life!
- ✓ The law of the Spirit of life is working in me. Hallelujah!

Turn In Scriptural Vouchers/ Coupons For Real Value

LESSON FOCUS

In today's class, we'll focus on the access that God has given us in His word to use as vouchers/coupons for all that we require to live a good life.

BIBLE STORY:

Teacher/parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

Romans 5:18-21 NIV

"Consequently, just as one trespass resulted in condemnation for all people, so also one righteous act resulted in justification and life for all people. For just as through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners, so also through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous."

The law was brought in so that the trespass might increase. But where sin increased, grace increased all the more, so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

BIBLE LESSON:

You are born of the Word and can only be kept by the Word of God. Just the way fish needs water to stay alive, you need the Word of God. You have to use the Word of God as your voucher or coupons for a prosperous and successful life. To turn in vouchers or coupons for actual values.

Redemption means I can take the vouchers of verses and scriptures of salvation and justification and redeem for actual value.

Our man of God said we should turn in scriptural vouchers or coupons for actual value. Did you know the scriptures that talk of Jesus vicarious death and resurrection are vouchers for redemption? Did you know that those verse are vouchers/coupons? You can take those coupons and present them for actual value. Study God's word and know the scriptures for yourself. You cannot turn in what you don't have knowledge of.

2 Corinthians 3:5 in the Amplified translation says, "Not that we are fit (qualified and sufficient in ability) of ourselves to form personal judgments or to claim or count anything as coming from us, but our power and ability and sufficiency are from God." Jesus has paid the price through His death and resurrection. Make claims on the blessings Christ gave you. You're to look beyond what your physical ability can do, now that Christ is in you. Your sufficiency is God-sufficiency. Hallelujah!

This was David's mentality when he confronted Goliath. He eye-balled the giant and said, "I'll cut your head off your shoulders today and feed your carcass to the birds of the air" (1 Samuel 17:46). How could David, a mere stripling, make such a boast? He had learn to look beyond himself, and his knowledge of God gave him boldness. He said to Goliath, "I come against you in the Name of the Lord of host, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied" (1 Samuel 17:45).

David was saying, "I may be the one standing before you, but God is actually the One standing against you, because I'm standing in His Name, not in my name. I'm functioning in His might, not mine!" Hallelujah! His scriptural coupon/voucher was the knowledge of whom God is and what He is capable of doing through him no matter the adversary. Our man of God said this is a year that will bring a lot of changes. You cannot fear your adversary, it will empower them. Your adversary is not God, your adversaries are not as strong as you think, in fact, they are weak.

Live with this consciousness throughout the year, because even better than what David had, the greater One lives in you today. He speaks through you, heals the sick through you and blesses through you. You have all His power and the limitless resources of His word domiciled in your spirit as your voucher/coupons for a life of victory. Glory to His Name forever!

Action

Set a time that you will study the Word of God throughout the year. Our Man of God said we should read chapter 5 of Romans.

MEMORY VERSE: Colossians 3:16

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom.

Affirmations:

Walk In Absolute Victory

LESSON FOCUS

In today's class, we'll focus on walking in absolute victory. The children will learn how to walk in absolute victory.

BIBLE STORY:

Teacher/parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

2 Corinthians 2:14-17 NKJV

"Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and through us diffuses the fragrance of His knowledge in every place. For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things? For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ."

BIBLE LESSON:

To be justified is to be declared not guilty; it's to be acquitted, declared righteous. Hallelujah! And it happened without you having to do anything to qualify for it; it was without a cause, but by the faith of Jesus Christ. It's not about your works or self-righteous acts. Romans 5:1 declares that we're justified by faith and at peace with God. That's who the new creation is; he has no sin, because he's a new creature, who never existed before. All things have become new.

The day you were born again, you were born into the life of total and absolute victory. Jesus' death on the cross made you one with Him, and ushered you into the transcendent life of victory. Some folks believe life is full of "ups and downs," but that's because they're not acquainted with the vital realities of the gospel of Jesus Christ. As a child of God, you're called to live each day of your life in victory over every situation. That's the lifestyle of the believer who has been justified.

Now is the time for you to walk in victory over sin, the devil, sickness, death and the circumstances of life. As far as God is concerned, nothing in this world could defeat you, for "greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world" (1 John 4:4). This is your year to reign—this is your time to manifest the victory that Christ wrought for you.

One beautiful thing about the salvation we have in Christ is that we have absolute victory over the enemy and can serve God without fear. We've been delivered from the powers of darkness and translated into the glorious Kingdom of God's dear Son, who leads us in the paths of righteousness and in absolute victory. Thus in Christ, your life is a victory parade. It doesn't matter who stands against you or makes a decree against you; our Man of God said not to fear the adversary; it doesn't matter what they say about you or against you, you have absolute victory in Christ.

There's no challenge big enough and no demon powerful enough to stop you from walking in victory! The Bible says "You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies..." Psalm 23:5. This year you will experience the miraculous, you're an answer, you will walk in where you're needed. Say I'm an answer, a package of solutions. Hallelujah!

You need to walk in the light of your victory. What does it mean to walk in the light of your victory? It means to live with the consciousness that you're a victor in Christ Jesus. It means to have the winning mentality; the mindset of a victor. This is the year of redemption and we're going to walk in absolute victory more than ever before. Hallelujah!

Action

Make plans to win souls more than ever before. Let others know about Jesus so they can experience redemption in Christ Jesus.
