

LESSON FOCUS

The children will learn the meaning of the word of the month Conglutination. They will learn that God's children should work together for the sake of the gospel. Glory to God

Bible Story:

Teacher/Parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

2 Timothy 2:4-5

No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.



Our Man of God declares this month as the month of Conglutination. Wow, welcome to the month of Conglutination! First, let's learn the meaning of CONGLUTINATION.

In several English Dictionaries conglutination is defined in the following ways;

- 1. To unite by or as if by a glutinous substance
- 2. To glue together
- 3. To join or become joined with or as if with glue

Our Man of God defines conglutination as a coalescence, it's like when broken bones are coming together and growing together. We coalesce (glue) together around a vision. Striving together for the faith of the gospel. Such kind of togetherness will bring forth a consolidation in the spread of the gospel.

Pastor read to us in 2 Timothy 2:4 KJV, "No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier."

Pastor said, no soldier ever fights for himself. There is no such individual soldier. No soldier ever works alone; every soldier belongs to an army. Remember, no one ever works alone. Then in the next verse there's another thing to observe," And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully." (5) The word strive as you see from this scripture is what athlete do to win, it's derived from the Greek word **Athléō**.

Philippians 1:27-28, "Only let your conversation be as it become the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind STRIVING TOGETHER FOR THE FAITH OF THE GOSPEL; and in nothing terrified by your adversaries: which is to them an evident token of perdition, but to you of salvation, and that of God."

God wants us to strive together, contend together, to be with one mind for the sake of the gospel. When we put up our forces together, nobody can beat us. There's no force, no power on earth can defeat us. When we work together, no power on earth can beat us. We win all the time, irrespective of the forces, irrespective of the adversaries. It makes no difference who they are. It doesn't matter who they defeated before, when they come to us, they fall. Hallelujah!

Philippians 1:27 NIV

Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit,[a] striving together as one for the faith of the gospel.

LESSON FOCUS

Bible Story:

Teacher/Parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

Ephesians 4:11-16 NIV

"So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.

Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work."

Striving together, contending together, to be with one mind for the sake of the gospel. Our man of God called the word strive ''SUNATHLEO'' in Greek. It means to wrestle in company with, i.e. to seek jointly; labour with, strive together for.

When we put together our forces, nobody can beat us. There's no forces, no power on earth can defeat us. When we work together, no power on earth can beat us.

Our greatest weapon is to conglutinate in faith for the sake of the gospel. We win all the time, irrespective of the forces, irrespective of the adversaries. It makes no difference who they are. It doesn't matter who they defeated before, when they come to us, they will fall. Hallelujah!

The evil shall bow before the good, and the wicked at the gate of the righteous Proverbs 14:19. They may have won wherever they were, but not with us. Ones they decide to fight us, they'll fail. Read our history, we've come a long way. The Bible tells us everything, it cannot lie.

The Bible says in 1 John 5:4-5 (KJV), "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith." Anything born of God overcomes the world. Its our faith, not just faith by anybody, it's our faith. This faith is in Christ Jesus. He told us not to have fear. The Bible says, "Ye are of God little children and have overcome them..." 1 John 4:4 It's not a promise, or an effort, we have overcome them. We've been made more than conqueror, our victory have been ssigned, sealed and delivered, because Greater is He that is in us than He that is in the world. Hallelujah!

WEEK 4

WHY DO WE PRAISE?



LESSON FOCUS

The lesson focuses on the reasons we praise God. The children will learn from Paul and Silas, how they prayed while in prison until they got victorious.

Bible Story:

Teacher/Parent, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

Acts 16:25-36

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. 26 Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everyone's chains came loose. 27 The jailer woke up, and when he saw the prison doors open, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself because he thought the prisoners had escaped. 28 But Paul shouted, "Don't harm yourself! We are all here!"

29 The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. 30 He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?"

31 They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household." 32 Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all the others in his house. 33 At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his household were baptized. 34 The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with joy because he had come to believe in God—he and his whole household.

35 When it was daylight, the magistrates sent their officers to the jailer with the order: "Release those men." 36 The jailer told Paul, "The magistrates have ordered that you and Silas be released. Now you can leave. Go in peace."



In the New Testament, we offer spiritual sacrifices called praise (Hebrews 13:15, 1 Peter 2:5, Psalm 69:30-31). Hence, praise is an expression of worship. When we praise God, we're worshiping Him. When you say, "Lord, you're good; you're kind, gracious and loving; you've blessed me, you're righteous, etc., you're defining, recognizing, and appreciating His character and His works.

We praise God because God intended for His people to be a people of praise. "When we praise God, we're positioned where we ought to be. Anything is possible. Glory!

Praise is the fruit of our lips—giving thanks to God (Hebrews 13:15). So, in worship or praise, you're saying something to God thankfully. This profuse expression of appreciation of His character and personality in words of thanksgiving should be from the heart; that is the spirit, not the flesh.

You can praise God anywhere and every where you find yourself. Let the songs of praise from our Loveworld singers always be on your lips. You can be so engrossed that no songs will interest you anymore aside songs from Loveworld singers.

Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name. Hebrews 13:15 NKJV
