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Preschool Service Outline Time Duration: 2hours

GENERAL GROUP ACTIVITIES (30 mins)

Check-In (10 mins)

Loveworld Children's Ministry Sing-Along can play in the background of the welcome stand to make the environment welcoming.

Assembly/Welcome (3 mins) Welcome to children warmly and introduce yourself with a smile. Tell them to welcome each other as well. They can ask for their names, especially the children that don't know each other.

Opening Prayer (5mins)

Lead the children in prayer. Engage them to speak in tongues and to give thanks to God. Round the prayer up, thanking God that their hearts are open to receive the word.

Praise and Worship (12 mins) Teach them a new song from the Let the children sing along with you as you lead them in songs chosen from the Loveworld Singers.

Choose songs that extol the virtues of God as the creator of the universe. Demonstrate with a show of hands as you sing, so they can take part actively.

AGE LEVEL CLASS ACTIVITIES (30 mins)

Rhapsody of Realities "Read To Me" Time (5 mins) Read the Rhapsody of Realities for Kids (Age 1-5) for the day and lead the kids in the confession enclosed in the devotional article.

Review Time (Previous Lesson) (5mins)

Children should say the topic and recite the memory verse for last week. They should briefly tell the class what they learnt last week.

Bible Lesson Time (20 mins) Make the lesson interactive with the children. Ask questions as you teach to ensure they are actively taking part. Use the interest builder to get their attention and relate the topic to them. Praise and acknowledge every child who attempts an answer. A reward sticker/badge can be given at this moment.

RELATE (45 mins)

Salvation Moment (3 mins)

Lead children who are yet to make Jesus their friend in the salvation prayer.

Confession(5 mins) Lead the children in confession using the confessions and affirmations at the end of each lesson.

Welcome First Timers (2 mins)

Welcome first-timers singing the Christ Embassy welcome song and encourage the other children to go over and say hello to them.

Tithe, Offering, Partnerships and Special Seeds (5 mins) Tell the kids to bring out their offering and other seeds. Using the offering bag, go round and collect the offerings. Sing a loveworld song that the kids already know or the sing-along from the lesson of the day. Bless the offering afterwards.

Friendship Circle Time (Cell Meeting) (30 mins) The children should divide themselves according to their cell groups.



Preschool Service Outline

Time Duration: 2hours

ACTIVITY & SNACK TIME (10 mins)

Snacks time (5 mins) The kids can have the snacks that they brought to church.

Activity Time (Optional) (5mins) If there is still time, keep the children busy with the lesson activity for the day.

CLOSING TIME (5 mins)

Announcement (2 mins) Remind the kids to study God's word using the daily memory verses that have been printed and distributed to them, go through their notes during the week and also do the lesson activity if they didn't at church.

Closing Prayer, Benediction and Check-Out Time (3 mins) Lead the children in prayer. Engage them to speak in tongues and to give thanks to God for the new week.Round the prayer up and say the benediction.

WHAT IS FAITH ?



Welcome & First Activity

Teacher: kindly establish relationship with the kids when they arrive. It is good to have a conversation, sing and pray before start of the lesson. (Prepare the room together)

Introduction

This month, we will start with a new theme titled **"Faith**. And our topic today is **"What is faith?"**..

Teacher: Use the craft to introduce the lesson in a fun way

Previous Knowledge

Hello children! Are you glad to be in church today? (Allow time for the children to respond)

Teacher should ask the kids to mention what they learnt from the previous themed curriculum. Kindly do a summary of previous curriculum theme with the kids, before introducing the new theme "Teaching On Faith".



Materials:

Cardboard

- Pencil
- Glue
- Fabric
- Scissors
- Cello-tape

Method:

- Write the letters 'I Have Faith' on the cardboard boldly.
- Use the scissors to cut out the letters.
- Place the letters to the fabrics and cut it to the shape of the letter.
- Leave enough space to fold the fabric over to the letters.
- Use a glue on the letter and fold the fabric to the letter.
- Hang on the wall by putting a cello-tape to the back of the letters.

Highlight

Teacher: read to the children Hebrews 11:1, 8-12, 17-19 (GNT)

To have faith is to be sure of the things we hope for, to be certain of the things we cannot see. It was faith that made Abraham obey when God called him to go out to a country which God had promised to give him. He left his own country without knowing where he was going. By faith he lived as a foreigner in the country that God had promised him. He lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who received the same promise from God. For Abraham was waiting for the city which God has designed and built, the city with permanent foundations.

It was faith that made Abraham able to become a father, even though he was too old and Sarah herself could not have children. He trusted God to keep his promise. Though Abraham was practically dead, from this one man came as many descendants as there are stars in the sky, as many as the numberless grains of sand on the seashore.

It was faith that made Abraham offer his son Isaac as a sacrifice when God put Abraham to the test. Abraham was the one to whom God had made the promise, yet he was ready to offer his only son as a sacrifice. God had said to him, "It is through Isaac that you will have the descendants I promised." Abraham reckoned that God was able to raise Isaac from death—and, so to speak, Abraham did receive Isaac back from death. Also read Romans 4: 1-3 (ICB)

So what can we say about Abraham, the father of our people? What did he learn about faith? If Abraham was made right by the things he did, then he had a

reason to brag. But he could not brag before God. The Scripture says, "Abraham believed God. And that faith made him right with God." Faith is the proof of things not seen!

- Abraham, the man of faith!
 - Have faith in God!
- Believe and trust in God!

Story TIME

The Lord told Abraham to leave his father's house to a land that He would show him. Abraham believed in God and left. Some other time, God told him that he would have a son, even though he and Sarah his wife were old, but he believed God. God also told him to sacrifice his only son Issac, and he believed that God would raise Isaac from the dead.

Even though Abraham didn't see the promises that God made to him, his faith was proof that what God had promised will surely come to pass. And they all came to pass. God gave him with a son, willed the whole world to him, blessed him and made him a blessing to others.

When you read the scriptures and see what God has said about you, don't doubt it. Have faith in God's word and speak it into being. Don't see sickness, failure or pain; but see goodness, favour and abundance for that is what He has made available for you. Keep your trust in God's Word for it never fails. Faith always wins. Hallelujah!

Practice the Bible Story

Ask the children to stand and sit three times. Then explain to them that when you sit in a chair, you're showing faith that the chair will hold you. That's the same way they are to trust in the Word of God, knowing that the Word will keep and preserve them always.

Materials:

- Have 4 different colors of 20 balloons in a box (red, yellow, blue, and green)
- Using a paper cello-tape, write on the red balloons (Have), on the yellow balloon (faith), on the blue balloons (in), and on the green balloons (God).
- Keep 4 empty cartons that the children will sort the balloons into.
- Pick 4 children for each round, send them to the box of balloons, giving each child a specific colour to sort out and the carton to drop it.
- Use the balloons to teach them the topic for today.
- Have fun


And seven priests shall bear before the ark seven trumpets of rams' horns: and the seventh day ye shall compass the city seven times, and the priests shall blow with the trumpets.

Joshua was a man who had faith in God's Word. Once upon a time, God sent Joshua to take over Jericho. Jericho was surrounded by a strong wall and a gate that was locked. God told Joshua to tell the children of Israel, "Walk round the city for seven days, on the 7th day, walk seven times and then shout for victory". Joshua and the children of Israel had faith in God's word and on the 7th day, the wall fell flat.

What challenges are you facing? Do you want to be excellent at school? Do you have a friend that you have been trying to lead to Christ?Are you feeling pains in your body? The Word of God is the answer to every challenge. Have faith in God's word because that is the proof of your victory. Declare God's word over that situation and shout for victory. Glory!

Teacher should ask the kids to mention what they learnt from the previous week, and add a short recap of the lesson highlights learnt previously as a way of reminding the kids of the important nuggets from the previous class.

OBJECT LESSON GAME

Write '**I live by faith**' on heavy paper or cardboard, and then cut it into puzzle pieces for the children to assemble



Teacher: read to the children Exodus 14:5-6, 10-16(ICB)

The king of Egypt was told that the people of Israel had already left. Then he and his officers changed their minds about them. They said, "What have we done? We have let the people of Israel leave. We have lost our slaves!" So the king prepared his war chariot and took his army with him.

The Israelites saw the king and his army coming after them. They were very frightened and cried to the Lord for help. They said to Moses, "What have you done to us? Why did you bring us out of Egypt to die in the desert? There were plenty of graves for us in Egypt. We told you in Egypt, 'Let us alone! Let us stay and serve the Egyptians.' Now we will die in the desert."

But Moses answered, "Don't be afraid! Stand still and see the Lord save you today. You will never see these Egyptians again after today. You will only need to remain calm. The Lord will fight for you."

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Why are you crying out to me? Command the people of Israel to start moving. Raise your walking stick and hold it over the sea. The sea will split. Then the people can cross the sea on dry land.

Also read Exodus 14:21-22 (ICB)

Moses held his hand over the sea. All that night the Lord drove back the sea with a strong east wind. And so he made the sea become dry ground. The water was split. And the Israelites went through the sea on dry land. A wall of water was on both sides."



- Moses used his faith to divide the Red sea!
- Moses had faith in God!



When the children of Israel left Egypt, they got to the Red Sea and realized that Pharaoh was coming after them with his chariots. They were so fearful and started to speak fear. It looked so impossible to cross through the water. But Moses answered, "Don't be afraid! Stand still and see the Lord save you today. You will never see these Egyptians again after today. You will only need to remain calm. The Lord will fight for you." Moses through faith stretched his rod and the Red Sea divided for the children of Israel to walk on dry land Glory!

Do you cry when you feel pain? When you read and you don't understand, do you get angry? Do you talk only about fear when facing a challenge? No! That's not how to use your faith. Declare God's word over any situation you don't like. Give God thanks knowing that the situation has changed. Hallelujah!

BIBLE

Teacher: read to the children 1 Samuel 17:4-11 (NIV)

A champion named Goliath, who was from Gath, came out of the Philistine camp. His height was six cubits and a span. He had a bronze helmet on his head and wore a coat of scale armor of bronze weighing five thousand shekels; on his legs he wore bronze greaves, and a bronze javelin was slung on his back. His spear shaft was like a weaver's rod, and its iron point weighed six hundred shekels. His shield bearer went ahead of him.

Goliath stood and shouted to the ranks of Israel, "Why do you come out and line up for battle? Am I not a Philistine, and are you not the servants of Saul? Choose a man and have him come down to me. If he is able to fight and kill me, we will become your subjects; but if I overcome him and kill him, you will become our subjects and serve us." Then the Philistine said, "This day I defy the armies of Israel! Give me a man and let us fight each other." On hearing the Philistine's words, Saul and all the Israelites were dismayed and terrified.

Also read 1 Samuel 17:26, 32, 45--50 (NIV)

David asked the men standing near him, "What will be done for the man who kills this Philistine and removes this disgrace from Israel? Who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should defy the armies of the living God?" David said to Saul, "Let no one lose heart on account of this Philistine; your servant will go and fight him."

David said to the Philistine, "You come against me with sword and spear and javelin, but I come against you in the name of the LORD Almighty, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the LORD will deliver you into my hands, and I'll strike you down and cut off your head. This very day I will give the carcasses of the Philistine army to the birds and the wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel. All those gathered here will know that it is not by sword or spear that the LORD saves; for the battle is the LORD's, and he will give all of you into our hands."

As the Philistine moved closer to attack him, David ran quickly toward the battle line to meet him. Reaching into his bag and taking out a stone, he slung it and struck the Philistine on the forehead. The stone sank into his forehead, and he fell facedown on the ground.

So David triumphed over the Philistine with a sling and a stone; without a sword in his hand he struck down the Philistine and killed him. David had faith in God!

David defeated Goliath with Words!

The Philistines were at war with the Israelites. Goliath was a giant and a soldier in the Philistine army. The Israelites were afraid of him. He spoke words of fear and threatened the army of Israel.

One day, David heard Goliath talking and asked the armies of the children of Israel what they would do for the man who defeated Goliath. He was told the reward and without fear, he went to confront Goliath with a stone and a sling.

David used words to defeat Goliath. He kept speaking God's word and just a sling of stone, Goliath was on the ground defeated.

Through studying God's Word, you will know what to say when faced with challenges. Always study God's word and have time to confess those words.
