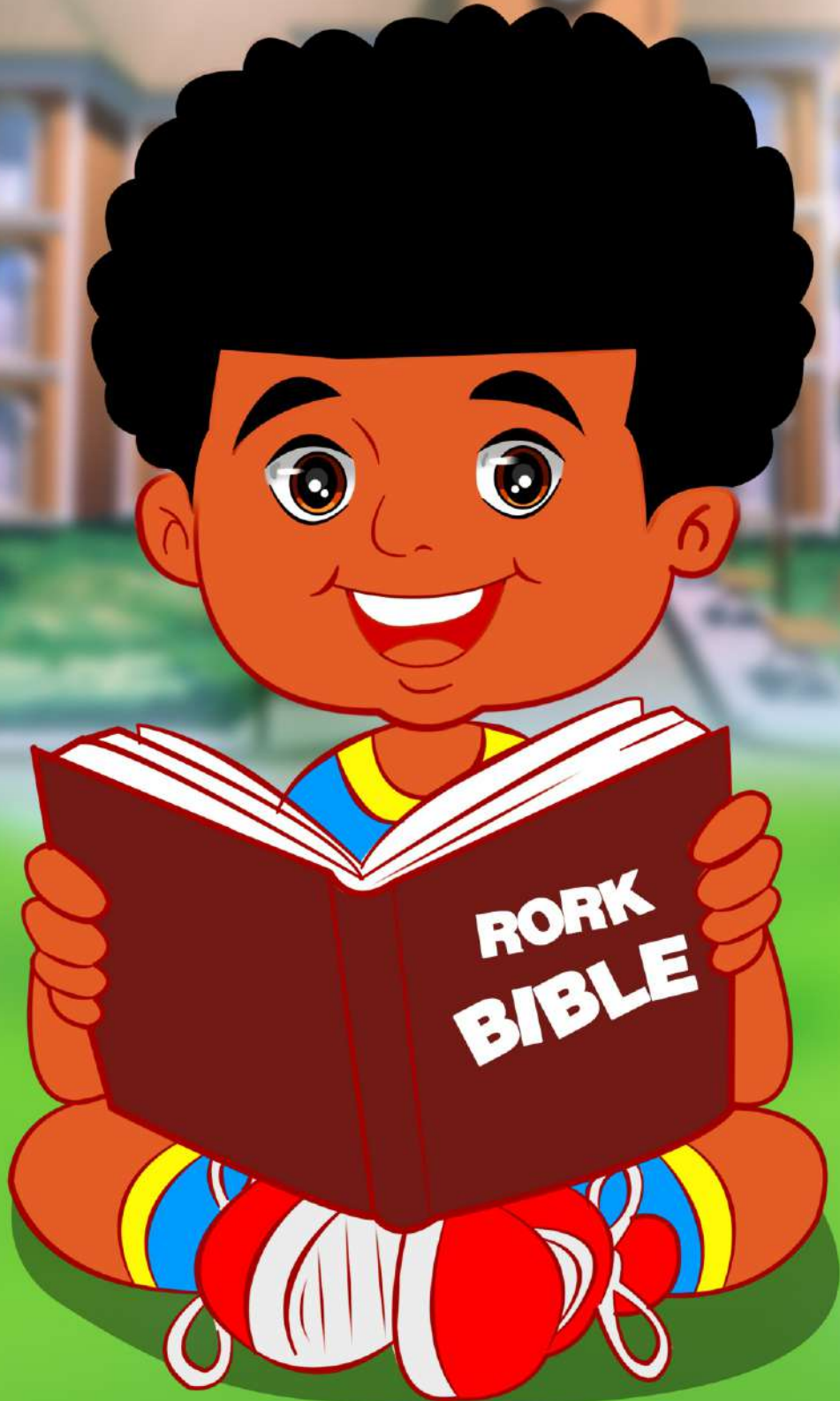

## Welcome & First Activity

These themes are declared during the Global Communion Services and are meant to guide the spiritual journey of members. This week we are looking at the February 2024 Word of The Month. Glory to God!



# READ THE BIBLE



Teacher read to the children **Philippians 1:27 ICB**

Be sure that you live in a way that brings honor to the Good News of Christ. Then whether I come and visit you or am away from you, I will hear good things about you. I will hear that you continue strong with one purpose and that you work together as a team for the faith of the Good News.

Also, read **2 Timothy 2:4-5 ICB**.

A soldier wants to please his commanding officer, so he does not waste his time doing the things that most people do. 5 If an athlete is running a race, he must obey all the rules in order to win.

## Let's See MORE

Every first Sunday of the Month, at the Global Communion Service with Pastor Chris, all Christ Embassy Members gather around the world to hear the Word to help them live right in the Month and beyond.

Last Sunday, at the Communion Service, Pastor explained that if you are born again, then you are a member of God's army. In God's army, you don't work alone. Remember that!

As a soldier you must please the one who sent you. You're to 'strive' in Greek 'athleó'. Athleó is where the English got the word athlete and athletics. We are to work in unity and the Greek word for this is sunathleō - a Greek word which means contending together on the same side. The Lord is telling us to be with one mind-striving together for the faith of the gospel.

Finally, Pastor declared the Month of February as the Month of Conglutination!

Watch out for the next lesson and learn about "Our Weapons of Conglutination". Hallelujah!

# READ THE BIBLE



**Teacher:** read to the children Psalm 33:5 KJV; 1 Corinthians 12:12-20 KJV

"He loves what is right and fair. The Lord's love fills the earth."

"A person's body is one thing, but it has many parts. Yes, there are many parts to a body, but all those parts make only one body. Christ is like that too. Some of us are Jews, and some of us are Greeks. Some of us are slaves, and some of us are free. But we were all baptized into one body through one Spirit. And we were all made to share in the one Spirit. And a person's body has more than one part. It has many parts. The foot might say, "I am not a hand. So I am not part of the body." But saying this would not stop the foot from being a part of the body. The ear might say, "I am not an eye. So I am not part of the body." But saying this would not make the ear stop being a part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, the body would not be able to hear. If the whole body were an ear, the body would not be able to smell anything. If each part of the body were the same part, there would be no body. But truly God put the parts in the body as he wanted them. He made a place for each one of them. And so there are many parts, but only one body."

## Let's See MORE

Conglutination means coming together for the sake of the gospel. When we do we become an undefeatable force.

This is because the bible says that evil bows before the good, and the wicked cannot stand against the righteous. (Proverbs 14:19 KJV).

With Conglutination, we can see broken bones coming together, growing, and merging around a shared vision, moving forward in unity.

Pastor Chris emphasized that when believers join forces, a powerful co-operation is created: No force or power on earth can defeat them. Victory becomes a constant reality in the lives of those who strive together for a common purpose.

In conglutination our weapons include the following.

i. Prayers and Fasting: Get involved when there is a call for Praying and fasting in your local Churches because you make power available when you do.

ii. Praise: When we praise God, we're worshipping Him and He makes us victorious.

iii. Fellowship: Children should attend all meetings in Church for which they are meant to be in attendance.

iv. Partnership: (Read 1 Kings 17:17-23). Never allow anything to stop you or discourage you from giving to the things of the Kingdom. Children, partner with the Lord big-time by investing your time and resources in world evangelism and you'd be glad you did.

**Practice the bible story:**

Encourage the children to work with the instructions given in the big Church.

## Let's See MORE

Why do we praise God? This is a very good question. The primary reason we praise God is because God wants us to praise Him. God planned for His people to be a people of praise."

Paul and Silas praised the Lord in Acts 16. They were excited in their praise and worship of the Lord. It was supposed to be for them a moment of pain, loneliness, and sadness, but rather than be devastated with lose of hope, they sang praises unto God. They didn't just mutter songs quietly, fearful of the prison guards, they sang as loud as they could such that the prisoners heard them. And guess what happened? The prison gate opened. Glory to God! Praise brought the power of God down and they were set free because they praised God.
