"Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ. Then, whether I come and see you or only hear about you in my absence, I will know that you stand firm in the one Spirit, [a] striving together as one for the faith of the gospel."

Oyakhilome, each month is associated with a specific theme or focus, often referred to as the "Word of the Month." These themes are declared during the Global Communion Services and are meant to guide the spiritual journey of members.

### **LET'S TALK:**

Last Sunday, being the first Sunday of the Month, as our custom is, all Christ Embassy Members gathered around the world to hear the Word to guide their Spiritual lives this Month and beyond.

Our Man of God using the theme scriptures above explained as follows;

An important thing about a soldier is that no soldier ever fights for himself. A soldier never works alone. A soldier always belongs to an army. There's no such individual soldier. Every soldier belongs to an army. If the Bible says that you have been chosen to be a soldier then it's letting you know that you belong in an army- in God's army so you don't work alone. Remember that!

In 2 Timothy 4:5 KJV bible says, "And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully."

The word 'strive' you see there is the Greek word 'athleó'. Athleó is where the English derives athletes and athletics. Something about this is what Pastor wants us to observe in Philippians 1:27.

"...striving together for the faith of the gospel". It's called sunathleō - a Greek word which means contending together on the same side. You are contending for something, but you are on the same side, against others. The Lord is telling us to be with one mind- striving together for the faith of the gospel.

This Month of February is the Month of Conglutination!

Other synonyms for conglutination are coalescence/coming together/growing together around a vision and moving together to bring a consolidation. It's like when broken bones are coming together. They come together and coalesce - merge. We'd be as one man striving together for the faith of the gospel. It will bring forth a consolidation. When we turn out en masse with our forces, no one can beat us! When we work together no force in the world can beat us.

What are you going to do with the word of the Month? Live the word. We 're children of the Word and must do the Word.

When believers join forces, a powerful synergy is created. As we embark on the Month of Conglutination, let's embrace the power of unity, strive together for the gospel, and experience the victory that comes when believers join forces.

Watch out for next lesson and learn a b o u t "O u r W e a p o n s o f Conglutination". Hallelujah!

### THE BIBLE CONNECTION:

### 1 Corinthians 12:12-20 KJV

"For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

For the body is not one member, but many. If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling? But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him. And if they were all one member, where were the body? But now are they many members, yet but one body".]



Conglutination is a powerful term, according to Pastor Chris, signifying the act of striving together as a force.

### **LET'S TALK:**

Conglutination speaks of the unity of believers, emphasizing that when we come together for the sake of the gospel, we become an undefeatable force.

This concept finds its root in the biblical truth that evil bows before the good, and the wicked cannot stand against the righteous (Proverbs 14:19 KJV).

With Conglutination, we can visualize broken bones coming together, growing, and coalescing around a shared vision, moving forward in unity.

Pastor Chris emphasized that when believers join forces, a powerful synergy is created: No force or power on earth can defeat them. Victory becomes a constant reality in the lives of those who strive together for a common purpose.

As Pastor explained, no soldier works alone and of course every soldier has the weapon of war. In conglutination our weapons include the following.

- i. Prayers and Fasting: In prayers, you converse with God your Father while fasting helps you to tame the flesh and lift the spirit. Get involved when there is a call for Praying and fasting in your local Churches because you make power available when you do.
- ii. Praise: When we praise God, we're worshipping Him. Psalm 133:1-2 KJV "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! 2 It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments.
- says "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. Children should attend all meetings in Church for which they are meant to be in attendance.
- iv. Partnership: (Read 1 Kings 17:17-23). Never allow anything to stop you or discourage you from giving to the things of the Kingdom. Partner with the Lord big-time by investing your time and resources in world evangelism and you'd be glad you did.



### **LET'S TALK:**

Why do we praise God? This is a very profound question. The foremost reason we praise God is because God wants us to praise Him. God intended for His people to be a people of praise. "When we praise God, we're positioned where we ought to be. He wants us to praise Him at all times irrespective of what we face.

Paul and Silas praised the Lord in Acts 16. They were exuberant in their praise and worship of the Lord. It was supposed to be for them a moment of gloom, loneliness and despondency, but rather than be overwhelmed with despair, they sang praises unto God. They didn't just mutter songs quietly, fearful of the prison guards, they sang as loud as they could such that the prisoners heard them.

This is one of the faith-ways to respond in the face of contrary situations; you praise and worship the Lord exuberantly, knowing that in Him you're more than a conqueror. If it seems as though you're in the "darkest hour" of your life, don't despair! Don't try to remind God of the problem, no; praise Him! You might say, "But if I don't tell Him my problems, He won't know what's on my mind"; you're wrong. He knows everything, because He's God.

Take your mind off the challenges and with a grateful heart, worship and extol His majesty; praise His Name, for He's the healer, the provider, the supplier of all good things, and He's greater than all. Adore Him for He's great and greatly to be praised. Even now, irrespective of the situation, praise Him! Think about everything He's done in your life! Think about His love, mercies, and grace towards you; think about His wonderful, glorious blessings in your life, and worship Him lavishly from your spirit.

Always praise Him; our God, our Lord, our Master, and our King, is worthy of all praise and worship.






