

UNDERSTANDING THE WORD OF THE MONTH



INTEREST BUILDER

What is prayer?

Our Man of God declares this month as the month of Prayer. Wow, welcome to the month of Prayer! First, let's learn the meaning of Prayer.

And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint (Luke 18:1).

Prayer is a privilege as well as a right given to us to approach the Father in faith through His Word, and by the Holy Ghost. The Father always wants us to take advantage of the opportunity and privilege of prayer. When Jesus said men ought always to pray and not give up, He was looking at the connection that we have with the Father; a connection that builds our faith through constant communication.

TO THE BIBLE:

Teacher/Parents, please read Luke 18:1-8 NKJV aloud to the kids.

Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, 2 saying: "There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. 3 Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.' 4 And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man, 5 yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.'"

6 Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said. 7 And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? 8 I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"



For some people, prayer is a mere ritual or religious ceremony. For example, the Pharisees, Sadducee, and Scribes in Bible days were given to the religiosity of prayer but not to its true essence and significance. But it wasn't so with the Patriarchs of faith like Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; they understood the importance and power of prayer as effective communication with God.

The Lord Jesus also demonstrated the power of prayer with amazing results. When Jesus said men ought always to pray and not to faint, He was looking at the connection that we have with the Father in our constant communication that builds faith. Faith comes by hearing the Word (Romans 10:17). Through that fellowship, we keep hearing the Word because the Father always speaks; He always talks to us; He always shares His Word with us.

Prayer is our way of carrying on the works of the Master. Prayer for the Church is not how we try to get what we want. Prayer in the Church is how we carry out God's will. Did you know that whatever you'd have desired in this world was already provided for you? In real Christianity there's hardly anything you need to pray for concerning yourself. Mention anything you'd ever need, and it's already provided for you. All that a Christian needs is how to appropriate whatever he requires. It's nothing to cry for.

1 Corinthians 3:21 says "So then, no more boasting about human leaders! All things are yours," All things are yours. He didn't say all things shall be yours, like looking at the future. Look at the next verse 22 "whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future—all are yours." He says if you choose to die it's all yours, it's your choice. It's all there. What isn't here? Is there anything that you'd ever desire that is not here. He mentions the whole world, things present and yet to come. Glory to God!

So, we understand that prayer is God's idea. He wants us to pray because He wants to answer. Prayer gives Him the right to intervene in the affairs of men and establish His will in the earth. Therefore, we pray with the understanding that our prayers make tremendous power available, dynamic in its working (James 5:16).




Prayer Of Salvation
