Intercession is a selfless act of compassion and empathy, demonstrating genuine concern for the well-being of others. According to Romans 8:26-28, the Holy Spirit intercedes for us according to God's will.

To effectively engage in intercessory prayer, individuals, groups, and churches are encouraged to organize prayer chain to get everyone involved.

There are certain rules guiding intercessory prayer which you must take into consideration they are:

- 1. You must know you're not interceding for yourself. The prayer of intercession is always on behalf of someone else.
- 2. You'll have to be persistent about whatever it is you're interceding for. This is because you're trying to prevail on someone else to align with God's will. In the prayer of intercession, you're concentrating the influence of God's power toward others for their good, and that requires some persistence in prayer. In the prayer of intercession, you don't stop praying until you get that note of victory in your spirit and are certain that you have what you asked for.






