Introduction

Hello children! (Allow response) Raise your hand if you took communion and listened to pastor's message at the communion service? That's good! We are going to learn about the word of The month. This month, our man of God declared March as the month of **FORMATIONS** during the communion service.

Previous Knowledge

READ THE BIBLE

Isaiah 10:12-19

Teacher/Parents, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

When the Lord has finished all his work against Mount Zion and Jerusalem, he will say, "I will punish the king of Assyria for the willful pride of his heart and the haughty look in his eyes. 13 For he says: "By the strength of my hand I have done this, and by my wisdom, because I have understanding. I removed the boundaries of nations, I plundered their treasures; like a mighty one I subdued their kings. As one reaches into a nest, so my hand reached for the wealth of the nations; as people gather abandoned eggs, so I gathered all the countries; not one flapped a wing, or opened its mouth to chirp."

Does the ax raise itself above the person who swings it, or the saw boast against the one who uses it? As if a rod were to wield the person who lifts it up, or a club brandish the one who is not wood! 16 Therefore, the Lord, the Lord Almighty, will send a wasting disease upon his sturdy warriors; under his pomp a fire will be kindled like a blazing flame.

17 The Light of Israel will become a fire, their Holy One a flame; in a single day it will burn and consume his thorns and his briars. 18 The splendor of his forests and fertile fields it will completely destroy, as when a sick person wastes away. 19 And the remaining trees of his forests will be so few that a child could write them down.

In several English Dictionaries formation is defined in the following ways;

1.The action of forming or process of being formed.

Our Man of God defines formation as the arrangement of people or things for unity; for a definite purpose. It is the act of forming or establishing something. In the realm of the spirit we are having military formations. Things are going on. We came together in February and in March we are getting organized. Something is happening in the realm of the spirit.

The Assyrian we read about in our Bible story represents the anti Christ the Antichrist. The Antichrist is the man that will rule the world after rapture. So, he cant rule us, we are for Christ. READ THE BIBLE

Joshua 6:1-11 NIV

Teacher/Parents, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

"Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. Then the Lord said to Joshua, "See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. 3 March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. 4 Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. 5 When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in."

So Joshua son of Nun called the priests and said to them, "Take up the ark of the covenant of the Lord and have seven priests carry trumpets in front of it." 7 And he ordered the army, "Advance! March around the city, with an armed guard going ahead of the ark of the Lord." When Joshua had spoken to the people, the seven priests carrying the seven trumpets before the Lord went forward, blowing their trumpets, and the ark of the Lord's covenant followed them. 9 The armed guard marched ahead of the priests who blew the trumpets, and the rear guard followed the ark. All this time the trumpets were sounding. 10 But Joshua had commanded the army, "Do not give a war cry, do not raise your voices, do not say a word until the day I tell you to shout. Then shout!" "

Let's See MORE

Our Man of God defines formation as the arrangement of people or things for unity; for a definite purpose. It is the act of forming or establishing something. In the realm of the spirit we are having military formations. Things are going on. We came together in February and in March we are getting organized. Something is happening in the realm of the spirit.

Being a member of God's army, there are formations you belong to. Each formation has its rules and regulations, as well as relevant instructions that comes. The Bible is our formation manual and as a soldier of Christ you just have to study it daily. When you study the Word of God, you're actually looking into the mirror of God, and you see yourself. As you study and meditate on God's word, what you see is the glory of God, and that glory is actually your true reflection, because God's Word mirrors you. It shows your identity, origin, potentials, and ability in Christ Jesus. Hallelujah!

Another importance of formation is the one we have through the Holy Spirit. In our formation as a soldier for Christ, the Holy Spirit is our guide. There're things that have been freely given to us of God, and the Holy Spirit open our eyes and helps us enjoy them. Many go through life without enjoying all that God has already prepared for them simply because they ignored the Holy Spirit. Some aren't even aware that God has given them a great life to enjoy. They carry on in life, walking in darkness, struggling, as though they had nothing from God.

No one who has the Holy Spirit should ever walk in darkness or uncertainty. He's the light of life. Through His light, you see all that God has blessed you with, and to walk in the light of your inheritance in Christ. Glory to God!

READ THE BIBLE

2 Corinthians 10:3-5

Teacher/Parents, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. 4 The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 5 We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

Let's See MORE

God designed weapons with which to pull down strongholds. We have such spiritual weapons that are mightily effective to pull down all the works of darkness and deceptions in the Nations of the world. It doesn't matter what forces are behind them; it doesn't matter that they use the media. The lying tongue is only for a short time, the lying tongue cannot be successful. In the day of the church when the spirit of truth is poured out on us around the world, the power of deception cannot prevail. We live and function by the spirit of truth and we are releasing truth to all Nations and deception cannot stand against this power of truth. Our weapon of formation is to spread the truth of God's word to others.

As you spread the gospel by telling others about Jesus, the Holy Ghost carries out His work of conviction on the Nations and He will convince them of truth. In Acts 2, the Holy Ghost came in full force to begin His ministry and He has been here ever since to guide men into all truth. Jesus said, "...I am with you always, even to the end of the age. Amen" (Matthew 28:20 NKJV). What a blessing! He's with you through the Holy Spirit. He didn't say, "I'll be with you"; it's not a promise. It's a fact. God's Word is a statement of truth, and our responsibility is to line up with His truth and live accordingly always.

READ THE BIBLE

2 Samuel 8:1-7

Teacher/Parents, please read the scriptures aloud to the kids.

And after this it came to pass that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Methegammah out of the hand of the Philistines. 2 And he smote Moab, and measured them with a line, casting them down to the ground; even with two lines measured he to put to death, and with one full line to keep alive. And so the Moabites became David's servants, and brought gifts. 3 David smote also Hadadezer, the son of Rehob, king of Zobah, as he went to recover his border at the river Euphrates.

4 And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David houghed all the chariot horses, but reserved of them for an hundred chariots. 5 And when the Syrians of Damascus came to succour Hadadezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men. 6 Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, and brought gifts. And the Lord preserved David whithersoever he went. 7 And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

Let's See MORE

Garrison is a group of troops stationed in a town to defend it. When soldiers conquer a country, town or place, they build garrison there.

According to our Bible story, David put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became servants to David. The Lord gave victory to David. In these last days, the Lord Jesus is building His Church. He said, "...I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it" (Matthew 16:18). There's a description given to us in the Word of God that shows how He's doing this. The Bible says He (Christ Himself), "...gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up" (Ephesians 4:11-12 NIV).

His plan is to build through these leaders, but everyone is involved; each one of us contributes to the building of this great body of Christ: "From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love" (Ephesians 4:16). You can build garrisons, through telling others about Jesus and encouraging them to do same. Also when you invite your friends in your area to form home cells. You can tell dad or mum to establish centre for Healing Streams live healing services with Pastor Chris. Build garrisons for God and establish the spread of the gospel in your environment.

Every time you lead someone to Christ, you're adding to the building of the Body of Christ, and it's a magnificent building. Hallelujah! Keep playing your role by winning souls into the Kingdom. You'll be contributing to the building of the magnificent structure.

Our garrisons include the different ways through which we take salvation to our world such as having home Cells, Neighbourhood Outreaches, Setting up of centres for Healing Streams Live Services with Pastor and much more.

We also make our defense of the kingdom using the word of God and of course our faith in God.

The place of prayers is not left out. Join Pastor on the daily Yookus prayers at noon and at night. Also participate in your local Church's prayer schedule times.

Remember that we must be intentional in making war for the kingdom to which we belong. Glory to God!
