

One can never be less than what one gives, for the more you give, the more you receive. The Lord Jesus alluded to this when He said in Luke 6:38 "Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom..."

PREPARATION

Here are a few ideas and tips to help you get ready for the day's activities and have a wholesome Children's Church Service!

- Review Teaching outline & guide with your team and devise a quick work plan to execute all the tasks outlined ahead of your service time.
- Pray for the children and every aspect of the service to be full of the spirit and have an irreversible impact on the children to the praise and glory of God.
- Print out the "Preteens Parent Communication Sheets" for the total number of children in your class. Print out all activity sheets. enclosed with this curriculum package, sufficient for the number of children in your class.

- Ensure you download related video and cue up in good time to play out.
- Arrive early!!! at least 45 minutes ahead of the scheduled start time for the service
- Make sure you are ready and the classroom is neat and tidy before the children arrive to welcome them warmly to Church.
- Have all required teaching and craft supplies available and well laid out ready for use.
- Let your creativity shine.... Feel free to explore ideas to translate the lesson for the day into decorative crafts to decorate your class or child spaces.



GENERAL GROUP ACTIVITIES (45mins)

Hence

1 CHECK- IN & WELCOME (5mins)

Ensure you are all ready and the class is set up ahead of the children's arrival. Be at the door to welcome the children. Greet each child by name. To create a warm, welcoming atmosphere, you can play Praise song by Loveworld singers in the background.

If you have a meeter/greeter team, that would be nice too; they can take the children around, showing them the lesson-related decorations to arouse their interest for what's ahead in the service. Use **Loveworld Children's Ministry Attendance Charts** for your check-in and registration of the kids as they come in. If you have a lesson-related sticker, this would be a good time to hand them out for that extra special welcome and to give the children a peek into what is to come in the Bible lesson for the day.

2 ASSEMBLY (40mins)

Assembly time gives opportunity for interaction across all age groupings as one big group. Children should be ushered to the assembly area straight after completing the check-in process. The Assembly Leader should be of a boisterous, cheerful personality that can engage every child and set the tone to help them get excited and ready for the day's activities before they break away to their individual classes.

Opening Prayer (1min)

Teacher appoints a child to lead the opening prayer.

Pastor Chris Live Pray-a-thon Segment (15mins)

The teacher leads the children to pray in tongues profusely using the Pray-a-thon post on the Pastorchris Live platform <u>www.pastorchrislive.org</u>





The teacher leads the children to sing along the songs for unending praise for that day. The teacher should make the songs available by visiting the LMAM website www.lmam.org

New Kids Welcome (2mins)

Don't forget to welcome new children (first timers) specially, with our Christ Embassy welcome song and encourage the regular kids to go over and say hello to make them feel even more welcome.

Small Group Activities

1. <u>Explore The Bible</u> (20mins)

• Rhapsody of Realities Time (3 minutes)

Get the children to be seated comfortably and read the devotional story in the **recent** <u>Rhapsody of Realties</u> <u>Devotional for Early Readers or you can alternatively</u> <u>use Teevo rhapsody for them</u>. Make the reading as interactive as possible. Lead the children in the confessions enclosed with the message in the devotional story.

15mins

o Interest Builder Activity (2 minutes)

As a warm-up to the lesson, lead the children in the interest builder activity as highlighted in the lesson overview enclosed with this curriculum.

o Bible Lesson Time (15 minutes)

Teacher: This is a very important segment in the day's activities.

Refer to the lesson summary in this curriculum and read it thoroughly, including the further scriptures, to ensure that you get all the shades of the lesson to help your presentation to the children.

Remember, you need to present the lesson in an engaging, interesting and interactive way that consistently captures the attention of your Preteens kids. Use the lesson illustrated Teaching picture and other tools enclosed with this curriculum.

2. <u>Relate Time</u> (20mins)

• Lesson Review & Talk Back Time (3 minutes)

Encourage feedback from the children. Use the **lesson discussion guide** provided with this curriculum. Ask the kids questions in line with the Bible lesson you have just taught and give opportunity for them to ask you questions if they have any as well. This would be a good time to use your reward stickers for pupils who answered right and made any attempt to answer a question.

• Confession (2 minutes)

Say out loud the confession for the day and have the children repeat the words of confession after you several times. Let them know that when we speak God's word like this in bold confessions, speaking the same things God has said in His word in agreement with him, we walk in the reality of what the scriptures declare as the Bible says "you shall have what you say" (Mark 11:23).

• Scripture Memorization (4 minutes)

One of the ways children learn is by repetition. Refer to the scripture memorization tip provided to help the children learn and memorize the scripture verse for the day.

- Lesson Memory Verse
- Message-For-The-Year Memory Verse
- Message- For-The-Month Memory Verse

• <u>Prayer (2 minutes)</u>

Lead the children in a simple prayer and give thanks for the message they have just received, thanking the Lord for the unlimited access that we have to Him.

• <u>Salvation Moment (3 minutes)</u>

This is an opportunity for any child who is yet to be born again to receive salvation. Give a brief message on the gospel and Christ's work of salvation. Ask the children to indicate by show of hands their desire to be born again and lead them in the prayer of salvation. Let them know the reality of what has just transpired – they are now a child of God and Jesus has come to live in them by His Spirit. Glory!

Teacher: Pray this prayer with any child who indicates he/she wants to receive Christ to live in him/her.

Dear God, I come to you in the Name of Jesus Christ. I confess with my mouth, Jesus Christ is Lord and believe with my heart that God raised Him from the dead. I receive Jesus today to be my Lord and friend. I am born again. I am a child of God Now and I've got the life of God in me. Amen.

• <u>Tithe & Offering Time</u> (2mins)

Giving Is Our Culture!

Lead the children in a simple prayer of thanksgiving and guide them to give their offerings and special seeds. Bless the offerings afterwards. Snack & Mingle Time (2mins)

Give the children a snack and packaged drink / water to get them refreshed for the next set of activities in the service. Encourage them to mingle and interact with each other.

Activity Time (2mins)

Refer to the lesson-related activity in the 'Activity Section' in the curriculum for and ensure you have sufficient supplies for the activities for the number of kids in your class. Have fun with your kids and remember to point out highlights from the lessons as the kids do the activities.

3. <u>Cell Meeting Time</u> (25mins)

The children should be supervised to split into their various cell groups for their cell meetings. Help first timers join a cell.

Adult Cell Supervisor/Teacher:

Remember to use the <u>Cell Meeting</u> <u>Outline</u> and make available to the cell leader the weekly cell meeting template relevant to the cell meeting type for the week.

NOTE: Adult Cell Supervisor or Teacher should participate in the cell meetings.

4. Checkout Time (5mins)

• Going Home Snack Time (2mins)

Please give the children a take-home snack to send them along the way home.

Bible Reading Plan Slip & Take Home Activity (3 mins) Give each child a copy of the Preteens 2 Year Bible Reading Plan and Take-Home activity sheets as applicable for the day.

5. <u>CLOSING (5 MINS)</u>

Talking Session & Closing Prayer

Lead the children in the closing prayers, a brief word affirmation session and benediction.

Remember to tell them you look forward to seeing them next week.

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



THE BIBLE CONNECTION:

Acts 16:25-34 NKJV

Teacher: Ask a child to read the Bible Verses:

"But at midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the prisoners were listening to them. Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were loosed. And the keeper of the prison, awaking from sleep and seeing the prison doors open, supposing the prisoners had fled, drew his sword and was about to kill himself. But Paul called with a loud voice, saying, "Do yourself no harm, for we are all here." Then he called for a light, ran in, and fell down trembling before Paul and Silas. And he brought them out and said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" So they said, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household." Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all who were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night and washed their stripes. And immediately he and all his family were baptized. Now when he had brought them into his house, he set food before them; and he rejoiced, having believed in God with all his household."

When we talk about worship, there're those who don't understand what it is. They wonder, "Who do you worship?" "Why do you worship?" "What are the benefits of worship?"

LET'S TALK:

What is praise? And what is worship? Worship is the recognition and appreciation of the reality, blessings, character, and greatness of God. This recognition and appreciation, we express in prayer, sacrifice, and service. In the New Testament, we offer spiritual sacrifices called praise (Hebrews 13:15, 1 Peter 2:5, Psalm 69:30-31). Hence, praise is an expression of worship. When we praise God, we're worshipping Him. When you say, "Lord, you're good; you're kind, gracious and loving; you've blessed me, you're righteous, etc., you're defining, recognizing, and appreciating His character and His works.

Praise is the fruit of our lips—giving thanks to God (Hebrews 13:15). So, in worship or praise, you're SAYING something to God thankfully. This profuse expression of appreciation of His character and personality in words of thanksgiving should be from the heart; that is the spirit, not the flesh.

The dancing that most people do in the church is in the flesh, which may have its place outside the church. In the New Testament, you don't dance in the flesh to worship God. Dancing in the flesh is based on the beat of the music. When the beat changes, the dance changes.

If you're inspired to dance, it should be in the spirit and by the Spirit. The dance may not even synchronize or follow the beat of the drums. In such situations, you'll find yourself jumping, spinning, rejoicing in and from your spirit. We're the true circumcision who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh (Philippians 3:3).

As we prepare for Special Editions of Praise Night with Pastor Chris, let's have this in mind and praise God from our spirit and not from our flesh because God is a Spirit, and we must worship and praise Him in the spirit. Hallelujah!

MEMORY VERSE: Philippians 3:3 KJV

"For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh".

The term "Fasting" generally involves putting away food for the sole purpose of engaging in uninterrupted study, prayer and meditation with a clear objective and goal in focus. It's not just abstinence from food alone but from all forms of distraction for the time being.

being. The scriptures are replete with numerous accounts of remarkable results and dramatic testimonies produced through Praying and Fasting. As Christians, Fasting is one of the godly exercises we should engage in regularly, with the promise of present and eternal benefits. The advantages are numerous, and here is an example:

In the 4th chapter of the book of Esther, we read how Esther had become queen, enjoying a wonderful life in the palace. However, she was unaware of a decree issued by Haman—a prominent but wicked figure who held a high position in King Ahasuerus's cabinet. Haman's plan was to exterminate the Jews, including Esther herself.

Esther called for a prayer and Fasting amongst her people and decided to go before the king to intercede for her people even though it was against the law and carried the risk of death. I love her resolve; she said, "...if I perish, I perish." In other words, "I'm going ahead with this, even if it's going to cost me my life." That was the moment she won!

One of the cravings of the body is food. It is a craving that is connected to the senses. When we fast, we deliberately abstain from food even though our body craves it. We resist the urge to eat thereby improving our mastery over the cravings of the body, and instead focus on activities that build the spirit. Of course, we could engage in activities that build our spirit without abstaining from food, but the abstinence from food adds a level of "seriousness" and "discipline" to the exercise.

When we Fast, abstinence from food is a key characteristic but that is not all. The Fasting exercise promotes focus and undivided attention to study and prayer.

When you declare a Fast, you are raising the stakes. It is a declaration of seriousness and urgency in addressing the matter at hand. It helps you to be earnest in your prayers and certainly it will be heartfelt. Your heart is in it to the point that you are giving up eating to tocus on the matter at hand. And when you pray like this, the results are guaranteed just as we saw with Queen Esther and her people.

Make a conscious effort to pray and fast. It is quite common for people to Fast when they are in dire need or in trouble, but you don't need to be in trouble or in a messy situation to be compelled to Fast. We can Fast to improve our spiritual acumen, stay ahead of situations, make general improvements in our life and to prepare for a greater future.

Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small loaf of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. For this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord sends rain on the land.'" She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah."



"As long as the world exists, there will be a time for planting and a time for harvest. There will always be cold and heat, summer and winter, day, and night" (Genesis 8:22 GNB).

One of the most profound principles in the Word of God that guarantee continuous increase in finances is the principle of giving. Not too many people are as excited to give as they are to receive; meanwhile, the promised blessing isn't to the receiver but to the giver.

LET'S TALK:

Jesus said, "...It is more blessed to give than to receive" (Acts 20:35). The Bible tells us about a certain

The Bible tells us about a certain widow in Zarephath who was poor and had nothing, yet the Lord commanded her to take care of prophet Elijah during the period of famine. Before meeting her, Elijah was being fed supernaturally by ravens that regularly brought him food, and he also drank from a brook (1 Kings 17:4). However, the brook dried up and the ravens stopped bringing him food. Then, God commanded him to go to the widow. By feeding Prophet Elijah, the widow received her miracle. The Bible says, "So she went away and did according to the word of Elijah; and she and he and her household ate for many days. The bin of flour was not used up, nor did the jar of oil run dry, according to the word of the Lord which He spoke by Elijah" (1 Kings 17:15-16).

Every opportunity you have to give to God is His way of setting you up for greater blessings. God doesn't ask you to give because He wants something from you, but because He's got something greater in store for you. Some have gotten frustrated because they had constantly given of their time and resources to the Lord and to the work of the ministry, and to them, it seems the circumstances of their lives have not improved. If only they knew that through their giving, God was setting them up for a greater and more glorious future, they would rejoice!

Not only did the Lord take care of the widow's immediate needs after she fed the prophet, He also took care of her future (Read 1 Kings 17:17-23). This widow gave to the Lord. Never allow anything stop you or discourage you from giving to the things of the Kingdom. Give to the Lord big-time by investing your time and resources in world evangelism and you'd be glad you did.


