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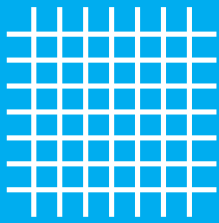

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Introduction

Loveworld Children's Ministry Specialty Curriculum is a topical scheme designed with related lessons for in-depth study of a particular subject matter presented with our unique learning approach. Our theme in this curriculum is, "**Faith**".

Faith is acting on God's Word. The Bible described Abraham as the father of faith. The Lord spoke to him to travel to an unknown destination that would become his home, and without further instructions, Abraham stepped out in faith. He didn't question the Lord; he simply acted on the instruction.

Lesson 1 ushers us into this intuitive study with the topic "**What Is Faith?**". The children will learn that faith is the confident assurance that what we hope for is going to happen. It is the evidence of things unseen but are real."

Lesson 2 is titled "**Faith Is Our Lifestyle**". In this lesson, our children will learn that in the Kingdom of God where we live, faith is our lifestyle. It isn't something we try to acquire; it's inherent in us. It came to us in the Gospel: "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God" (Romans 10:17). Romans 12:3 says, "...God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith." Hallelujah!

Lesson 3 is titled "**Never Get Frantic**". In this lesson, our children will learn that praying out of frenzy negates faith; makes it ineffective. They will learn to speak in tongues, but never out of fear in the face of challenging situations. While speaking in tongues, the Holy Spirit will also give them utterance in spiritual incantations which are coded words for the circumstances.

Lesson 4 concludes this curriculum with the topic "**Affirm The Word In Faith**". In this lesson, our children will learn that affirming the Word of God is a principle of the Kingdom that works for salvation (Romans 10:9-10) and everything else. You may pray and cry about a particular situation, but if you don't declare what the Word says about that situation, nothing will change. The children will learn to affirm the Word in faith.

PREPARATION

Here are a few ideas and tips to help you get ready for the day's activities and have a wholesome Children's Church Service!

- Review Teaching outline & guide with your team and devise a quick work plan to execute all the tasks outlined ahead of your service time.
- Pray for the children and every aspect of the service to be full of the spirit and have an irreversible impact on the children to the praise and glory of God.
- Print out the "**Preteens Communication Sheets**" for the total number of children in your class. Print out all activity sheets. enclosed with this curriculum package, sufficient for the number of children in your class.
- Ensure you download related video and cue up in good time to play out.
- **Arrive early!!!** at least **45 minutes** ahead of the scheduled start time for the service
- Make sure you are ready and the classroom is neat and tidy before the children arrive to welcome them warmly to Church.
- Have all required teaching and craft supplies available and well laid out ready for use.
- **Let your creativity shine....** Feel free to explore ideas to translate the lesson for the day into decorative crafts to decorate your class or child spaces.

Scope & Sequence

Time Duration:
2hrs

GENERAL GROUP ACTIVITIES (20mins)

o CHECK-IN & WELCOME (7mins)

Ensure you are all ready and the class is set up ahead of the children's arrival. Be at the door to welcome the children. Greet each child by name. Have your **Preteens Class Leadership Reps** for the week at the entrance with you to welcome the children warmly.

Use our **Loveworld Children's Ministry Attendance Charts** for your check-in and registration of the kids as they come in. If you have a lesson-related sticker, this would be a good time to hand them out for that extra special welcome and to give the children a peek of what is to come in the bible lesson for the day.

o Assembly (10mins)

Assembly time gives opportunity for interaction across all age groupings as one big group. Children should be ushered to the assembly area straight after completing the check-in process. The Assembly Leader should be of a boisterous, cheerful personality that can engage every child and set the tone to help it get excited, participate in the activities and ready for the day's activities as they break away to their individual classes.

o New Kids Welcome (3mins)

Don't forget to welcome new children (first timers) specially with our Christ Embassy welcome song and encourage the regular kids to go over and say hello to make them feel even more welcome

AGE LEVEL CLASS ACTIVITIES (15mins)

WELCOME & WORSHIP TIME

o Opening Prayer (2mins)

Prepare a brief Prayer outline ahead of the class and lead the children in an opening prayer to kick off this segment of the service. Alternatively, you can ask the children if any of them would like to volunteer lead the prayer or round off each prayer point.

(Please do not call on any new child or visitor to not put them in an awkward position and embarrass the child)

If you have any prayer outline and have sufficient time in your service schedule, you can go through them point by point and round each prayer point properly giving thanks to the lord for answered prayers and granting our petitions. We have made of Him.

o Praise & Worship Time (10mins)

Lead the children in praise worship, engaging them to participate actively, giving thanks to the Name of Jesus.

You can start with a brief exhortation on praise and worship... we are the circumcision that worship God in Spirit and in Truth and have no confidence in the flesh. God inhabits our praises and encourage them to lift their hands in worship to God.

o Healing Ministration Video Segment (3mins)

Get the children to watch the **Healing School Video of the Week**. This would be a good opportunity to talk about the importance of the miraculous in our Christian Walk today.... Even as kids! www.healingstreams.tv

Explore The Bible (25mins)

o Let's Talk – Review And Refresh (5mins)

Prepare a “**Lesson Review Guide**” ahead of this segment
Review the bible lesson previous week with the children. Ask them questions on what they learnt and how they applied it in their everyday lives and activities during the week.

Bible Lesson Time (20mins)

o Spark Interest!

Brief Interactive Discussion Session

Ask the children by show of hand to volunteer to share their thoughts on the meaning of the lesson related words or terminology highlighted in the lesson summary giving an example of application based on their explanation
(Acknowledge every participant for his or her input)

Round off this brief discussion by giving the definitions for the word or terminology reviewed.

o The Message for The Day

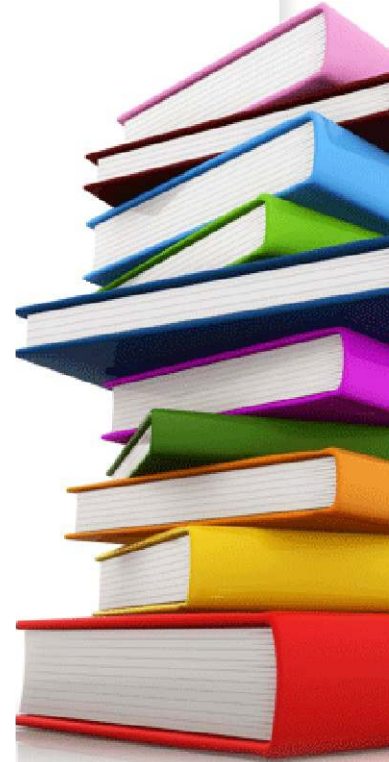
Teacher: This is a very important segment in the day's activities

Refer to the lesson summary in this curriculum and ensure you read thoroughly including the further scriptures to ensure that you get all the shades of the lesson to help your presentation to the children.

Remember, you need to present the lesson in an engaging, interesting and interactive way that consistently captures the attention of your preteens - Use the Teaching Picture and other teaching aid enclosed with this curriculum

Key Highlights of The Lesson For Your Preteens To Write Down:

Teacher: Refer to the highlight guide in the Lesson Summary for your preteens to write in their notebooks for reference and review at home.



RELATE TIME (60mins)

o Confession (2 mins)

Say out loud the confession for the day and have the children repeat the words of confession after you several times. Let them know that when we speak God's word like this in bold confessions, speaking the same things God has said in His word in agreement with him... We walk in the reality of what the scriptures declare as the bible says “you shall have what you say” Mark 11:23

o Let's Talk – Test Your Understanding (3 mins)

Teacher: Assign the children into groups.

Ensure you generate and have print copies of “**The Lesson Discussion Guide**” enclosed with this curriculum for each group leader.

Choose whatever format suits you – large group discussion or small groups. Have the kids discuss the lesson and share their thoughts while you or your assistants moderate the discussion. Give opportunity for questions and provide answers.

o Scripture Memorization (5mins)

One of the ways children learn is by repetition. Refer to the scripture memorization tip provided to help the children learn and memorize the scripture verse for the day.

- **Lesson Memory Verse**
- **Message-For-The-Year Memory Verse**
- **Message-For-The-Month Memory Verse**

o **Prayer & Salvation Moment (5mins)**

Prayer: Lead the children in a simple prayer and give thanks for the message they have just received; Thanking the Lord for the unlimited access that we have to Him.

Salvation Moment: This is an opportunity for any child who is yet to be born again to receive salvation. Give a brief message on the gospel and Christ's work of salvation. Ask the children by show of hand to indicate they desire to be born again and lead them in the prayer of salvation. Let them know the reality of what has just transpired - they are now children of God and Jesus has come to live in them by His Spirit. Glory!

Teacher; Pray this Prayer with any child who indicates he/she wants to receive Christ to live in them.

“Oh Lord God, I come to you in the Name of your Son, Jesus Christ. I believe in my heart that He came into this world and died for my sins and the sins of the whole world. I believe that He was raised up from the dead and He is alive today. I confess with my mouth, that Jesus Christ is Lord of my life. I receive eternal life into my spirit. Therefore, I declare that I am saved. I am born again. I now have Christ dwelling in me. Thank you Father. Amen!”

TITHE & OFFERING TIME

Giving Is Our Culture! (3mins)

Lead the children in a simple prayer of thanksgiving and guide them to give their offerings and special seeds. Bless the offerings afterwards.

SNACK & MINGLE TIME (2mins)

Give the children a snack and packaged drink / water to get them refreshed for the next set of activities in the service. Encourage them to mingle and interact with each other.

ACTIVITY TIME

Cell Meeting Time (20mins)

The children should be split into their various cell groups for their cell meetings. Help first timers join a cell.

Adult Cell Supervisor/ Teacher:

(Remember to use the [January 2024 Cell Meeting Outlines](#) and make available to the cell leader the Weekly Cell Meeting template relevant to the cell meeting type for the week.

NOTE: Adult Cell Supervisor or Teacher should participate in the cell meetings.

CHECK OUT TIME & CLOSING

o **Bible Reading Plan & Take Home Activity (15mins)**

Give each child a copy of **The Bible Reading Plan & Take-Home Activity Sheets** as applicable for the day.

o **Talking Session & Closing Prayer (5mins)**

Lead the children in the closing prayers, brief word declaration time and closing benediction with the children. Remember to tell them you look forward to seeing them next week.

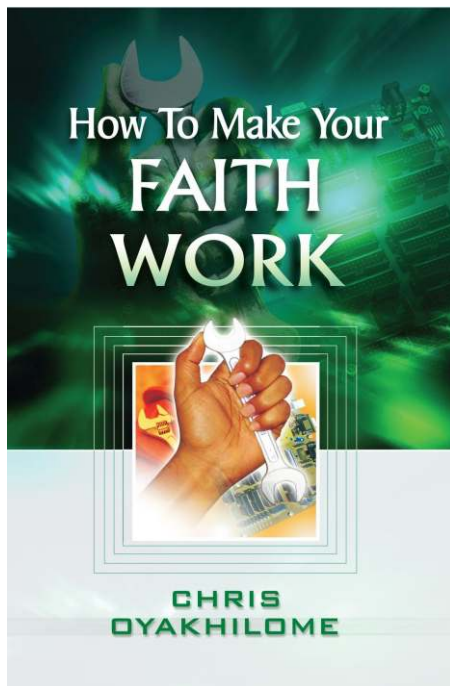

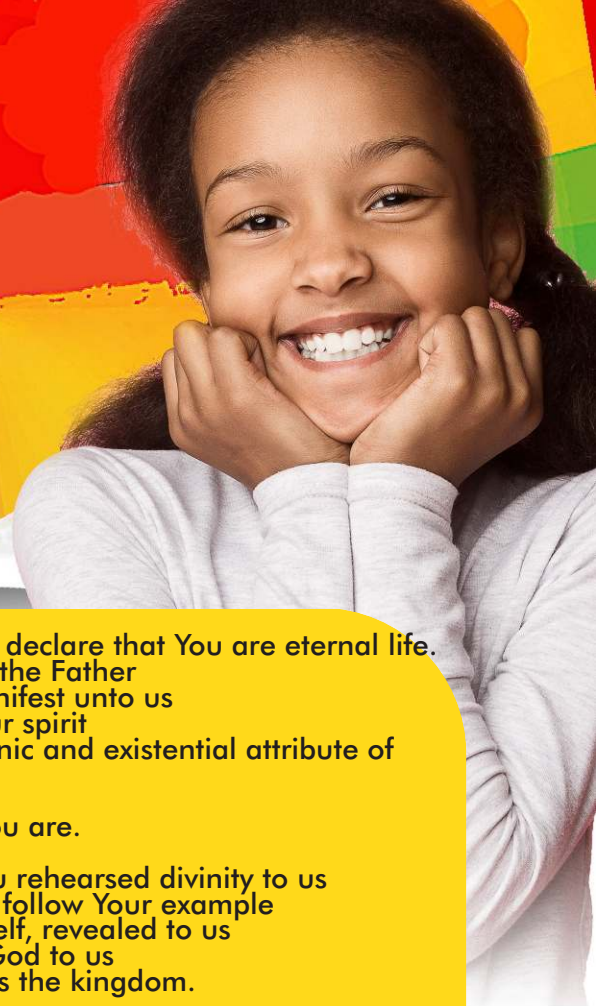

Lesson Summary

[So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God (Romans 10:17)]

A clear understanding and communication of the message of faith is important because faith is a principle by which we live in the Kingdom of God. The Bible says, "...the just shall live by faith" (Romans 1:17). It shows you just how important faith is. You can't understand and apply your righteousness in Christ without faith.

LET'S TALK:

What is Faith? Faith is a fundamental principle in Christianity. It is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1).

Faith is a principle by which we live in the Kingdom of God. The Bible emphasizes the significance of faith: "...the just shall live by faith" (Romans 1:17). Without faith, it is impossible to please God (Hebrews 11:6). Through faith, we activate and appropriate the blessings and provisions made available to us in the Gospel.

The Bible described Abraham as the father of faith. The Lord spoke to him to travel to an unknown destination that would become his home, and without further instructions, Abraham stepped out in faith. He didn't question the Lord; he simply acted on the instruction.

Jesus Himself taught the message of faith during His earthly ministry. He emphasized the principle of asking and receiving, saying, "...whosoever shall say unto this mountain, be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith" (Mark 11:23). Jesus assured that with faith, nothing would be impossible (Matthew 17:20).

Faith is the message of victory and triumph. It is the key to living a life of endless victories and possibilities. When we understand and apply faith, we tap into the supernatural and experience the miraculous. So, let us not underestimate the power of faith; it is the pathway to our divine inheritance and the life of Christ revealed in us.

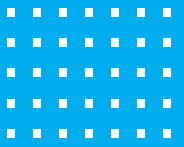

LET'S TALK:

Therefore, to live triumphantly in the Kingdom, you must put your faith to work. Failure to grow and exercise their faith is one of the

reasons many Christians suffer for a long time. Rather than acting their faith, they're more focused on their condition, complaining bitterly about what they're going through. That's not the way to function in the Kingdom of God.

What you must understand is that God has given you authority and power in the Holy Spirit to effect changes. It only takes you acting on the Word, and that's what faith is. Through faith, we activate the blessings and provisions of Christ made available to us in the Gospel. It's the reason Jesus taught the message of faith to the people in His day. But being born again, we're creatures of faith. Faith is our lifestyle. Hallelujah!

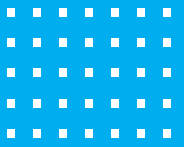

"God's Word tells us to be anxious for nothing; that means to have no anxiety about anything. Rather, in everything, by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, you should make your requests known to God."

LET'S TALK:

The Scriptures show us how to respond when we're confronted with challenges. Always, the Lord tells us not to fear. Never get frantic or flustered. We're creatures of faith and not fear.

In Mark 4, Jesus was in the boat with His disciples and there was a tempest: "And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full" (Mark 4:37). Rattled by fear, the disciples cried out to the Master who was peacefully asleep at the rear of the boat. He wasn't one to be flustered by circumstances.

When He woke up, He didn't say, "This storm is quite tumultuous and a serious threat to our lives! I need to talk to the Father." No! His amazing and inspiring response to the storm was, "Peace, be still!" Hallelujah! Some Christians find themselves in similar situations and respond in fear. They start speaking in tongues out of panic; no. Speak in tongues, but never out of fear.

Praying out of frenzy negates your faith; it's ineffective. It's not wrong to immediately start speaking in tongues when you're in certain situations, but you must know why you're speaking in tongues at such times. It should be to stir your spirit to pick the right words to deal with the situation.

While speaking in tongues, the Holy Spirit will also give you utterance in spiritual incantations which are coded words for the circumstances. Hallelujah! Refuse to fear and remember who you are; then speak as the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. Hallelujah!

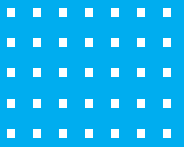

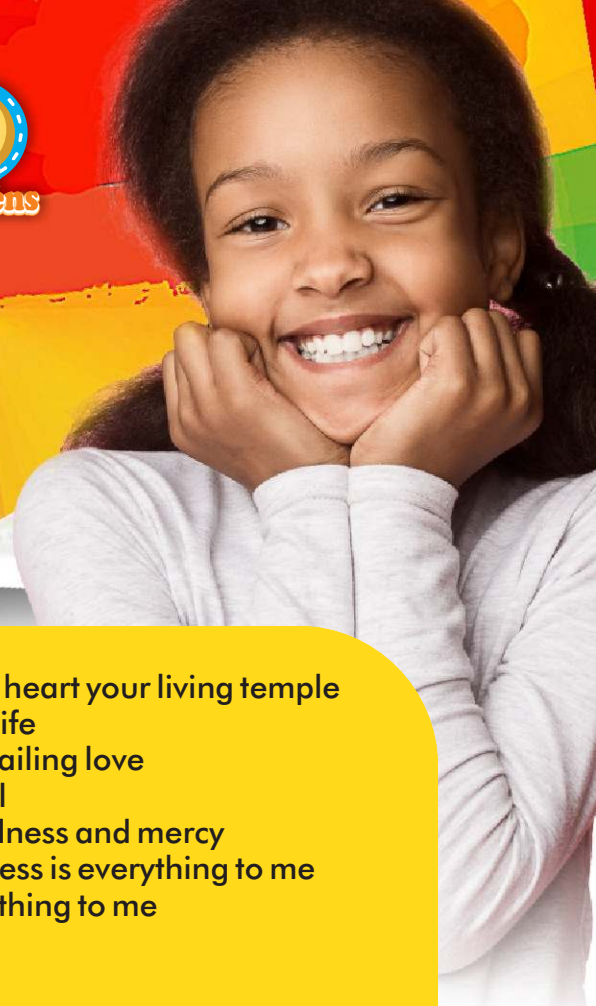

Lesson Summary

+ [*"For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith (1 John 5:4).]*

Faith is a very powerful spiritual force in the Kingdom of God; it's the principle by which we live, and our faith is based on the Word. The Apostle Paul, knowing the power of faith, declared, "I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me" (Philippians 4:13).

LET'S TALK:

What we read in Hebrews 10:23 reminds us of what Abraham did: "He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God" (Romans 4:20). How do you give glory to God? It's through your affirmation of His Word; your affirmation of His greatness, power, majesty, and love. When we talk about affirming the Word of God, there're those who wonder, "Must I say it?" Yes! It's a principle of the Kingdom that works for salvation (Romans 10:9-10) and everything else. In Mark 11:23, the Lord Jesus said, "You shall have what you say." Understand this: You're a spirit.

You may pray and cry about a particular situation, but if you don't declare what the Word says about that situation, nothing will change. Until you say what God has said concerning you, it's not established in your life. Hebrews 13:5-6 says, "...for he hath said...So that we may boldly say...."

You might have been praying, "Oh Lord, establish your Word in my life"; meanwhile, you're the one to establish it. The Bible says, "For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven" (Psalm 119:89). But you don't live in heaven; you live on earth. You're to establish His Word on earth. When God says it, you establish it by declaring the same thing. You might be troubled because your parents can't pay your fees yet, but you should say, "All things are mine! I have all things that pertain to life and godliness! God is able to channel all the resources that I need to me and much more; and He has, because He's my shepherd." Hallelujah! Make such proclamations continually and your whole spirit, soul and body, including circumstances, will conform to your affirmations. Refuse to fret. Keep affirming the Word. Your faith proclamations produce realities. Refuse to waiver, cower or stagger; be strong in faith, giving thanks to the Lord. Hallelujah!
